

PEAKS AND VALLEYS HAT



A simple stockinette stitch, broken up by purl ridges creates a ribbed and slouchy hat.

YARN

90-120 yards Lion Brand Vanna's Choice (100% acrylic;
170y/155m per 100 grams)

NEEDLES

US 9 / 5.5 mm 16" circular needle
US 9 / 5.5 mm double pointed needles

NOTIONS

One stitch marker
Darning needle for weaving in ends

GAUGE

16 sts x 20 rows = 4" in stockinette

SIZES

baby (toddler, child, adult) = 9 (10, 11, 12) inches wide,
un-stretched.

ABBREVIATIONS

CO = cast on
DRnd = decrease round
K = knit
K2TOG = knit two stitches together
P = purl
RND = round
STS = stitches

DIRECTIONS

Using long tail method, CO 56 (64, 72, 80) sts. Place marker to join, being careful not to twist.

Rnd 1-8: [K 2, P 2] around.

Rnd 9-11: K all sts.

Rnd 12: P all sts.

Repeat rnds 9-12 a total of 5 (6, 8, 10) times.

SHAPE CROWN

(switch to DPNs when necessary)

DRnd 1: (k6, K2tog) around.

DRnd 2 (and all even rows): K all sts around.

DRnd 3: (k5, k2tog) around.

DRnd 5: (k4, k2tog) around.

DRnd 7: (k3, k2tog) around.

DRnd 9: (k2, k2tog) around.

DRnd 11: (k1, k2tog) around.

DRnd 13: K2tog around.

FINISHING

Break yarn, leaving a long tail. Use darning needle to thread yarn through remaining sts. Pull yarn tight and secure.

Weave in all ends.
