

Cute Little Bunny Amigurumi Pattern

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A bunny with a granny square body & removable flower accessory. I hope you enjoy this pattern!

Materials:

- Worsted weight yarn in brown, pink, soft green, and black. (I used Loops & Threads Impeccable, Vanna's Choice Baby, and Caron Simply Soft)
- Pair of 18mm safety eyes

- Small button
- Stuffing
- Long strip of fabric to use as stuffing for body

Tools:

- E/3.5mm hook
- Yarn needle

Size:

Approximately 6.5" (16.5cm) tall and 3.5" (9cm) wide from ear to ear. Results will vary depending on your tension and your yarn & hook choice.

Abbreviations:

Ch - Chain

Sc - Single crochet

2 sc - 2 single crochet increase

Sc2tog - 2 single crochet decrease

Hdc - Half double crochet

Dc - double crochet

Sl st - Slip stitch

St(s) - Stitch(es)

R# - Round/Row #

Rep - Repeat

Spc - Space

Beg - Beginning

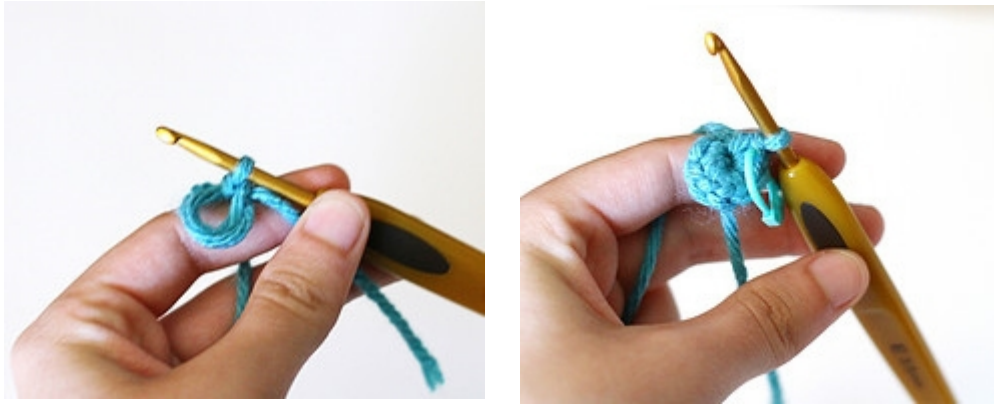
Magic Ring:



A few inches from the end of the yarn, wrap two loops over your finger. While the loops still on your finger, insert the hook from right to left into the loops and pull the working yarn through.



Carefully take the loops off your fingers and chain one. This doesn't count as the first stitch.



Insert the hook into the two loops again and pull up a loop. Yarn over and draw through both loops. This counts as the first single crochet stitch. Continue for the rest of the stitches. Then pull the yarn tail to close the hole.

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Head:

With brown yarn,

R1: 6 sc into magic ring.

R2: 2 sc in each st around. (12 sts)

R3: *2 sc in st, sc in next st* rep to end. (18 sts)

R4: *2 sc in st, sc in next 2 sts* rep to end. (24 sts)

R5: *2 sc in st, sc in next 3 sts* rep to end. (30 sts)

R6: *2 sc in st, sc in next 4 sts* rep to end. (36 sts)

R7-10: Sc in each st around. (4 rounds)

Put the safety eyes into the head above the last round (between R9 & R10) with 10 sts in between.

R11: *Sc2tog, sc in next 4 sts* rep to end. (30 sts)

R12: *Sc2tog, sc in next 3 sts* rep to end. (24 sts)

Start stuffing.

R13: *Sc2tog, sc in next 2 sts* rep to end. (18 sts)

R14: *Sc2tog, sc in next st* rep to end. (12 sts)

Fasten off, leaving a tail. Thread yarn onto yarn needle and insert the needle through the front loop of each stitch. Pull the tail to tighten the

Snout:

With brown yarn,

R1: 6 sc into magic ring.

R2: 2 sc in each st around. (12 sts)

R3: Sc in each st around.

Stuff. Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

Nose:

With pink yarn, stitch the nose onto the snout. Start from the bottom going up making a triangular shape then stitch on the top 2-3 times. Stitch a short horizontal line on the bottom where you started as well as on each side of the nose to make it more rectangular.





Mouth:

With black yarn, stitch a small vertical line starting at the same center spot and going down.



Then sew the snout onto the head centered between the eyes.

Ears (Make 2):

With brown yarn,

R1: 8 sc into magic ring.

R2: *2 sc in st, sc in next 3 sts* rep to end. (10 sts)

R3-8: Sc in each st around. (6 rounds)

Don't stuff. Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing. Pinch the bottom of the ears together and then sew it on

top of the head spaced about 2-3 stitches away from the eye and on R4 of the head.



Body:

Crochet over your ends as you go along.

With soft green yarn,

R1: Work into magic ring: Ch 2 (counts

as first hdc), 2 hdc, ch 1. *3 hdc, ch 1* x3. Sl st to beg ch 2 to join. Fasten off. (4 hdc groups)

With brown yarn,

R2: Insert hook into corner ch spc, ch 2 (counts as first hdc), 2 hdc, ch 1, 3 hdc in same ch spc, ch 1. *3 hdc, ch 1, 3 hdc, ch 1* into the next 3 ch spc. Sl st to beg ch 2 to join. Fasten off. (4 hdc corner groups)

With pink yarn,

R3: Insert hook into corner ch spc, ch 2 (counts as first hdc), 2 hdc, ch 1. *3 hdc into next ch spc, ch 1* x7. Sl st to beg ch 2 to join. Fasten off. (8 hdc groups)

With brown yarn,

R4: Insert hook into a ch spc, ch 2 (counts as first hdc), 2 hdc, ch 1. *3 hdc into next ch spc, ch 1* x7. Sl st to beg ch 2 to join. Fasten off. (8 hdc groups)

With soft green yarn,

R5: Insert hook into a ch spc, ch 2 (counts as first hdc), hdc, ch 1. *2 hdc in next ch spc, ch 1* x7. Sl st to beg ch 2 to join. Fasten off. (8 hdc groups)

With brown yarn,

R6: Insert hook into a ch spc, ch 2 (counts as first hdc), hdc, ch 1. *2 hdc in next ch spc, ch 1* x7. Sl st to beg ch 2 to join. Fasten off. (8 hdc groups)

With pink yarn,

R7: Insert hook into a ch spc, ch 2 (counts as first hdc), hdc. *2 hdc in next ch spc* x7. Sl st to beg ch 2 to join. Fasten off. (16 sts)

With brown yarn,

R8: Insert hook into a st, ch 2 (counts as first sc). Sc in next 15 sts. Sl st to beg ch 2 to join. (16 sts)

Stuff with a long strip of felt or leftover fabric. Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing. Sew body onto the head.





Arms (Make 2)

With brown yarn,

R1: 6 sc into magic ring.

R2: *2 sc in st, sc in next 2 sts* rep



to end. (8 sts)

R3-7: Sc in each st around. (5 rounds)

Stuff halfway firmly. Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing. Sew onto the body.



Legs (Make 2):

With brown yarn,

R1: 8 sc into magic ring.



R2-4: Sc in each st around. (3 rounds)

R5: *Sc2tog, sc in next 2 sts* rep to end. (6 sts)



R6: Sc in each st around.

Stuff halfway firmly. Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing. Sew onto the body.



Tail:

With brown yarn,

R1: Work into magic ring: ch 2, 9 hdc. Sl st to beg ch 2 to join.



R2: Ch 2, hdc in same st as join. Hdc in next 8 sts. Sl st to beg ch 2 to join.

Stuff. Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.



Flower:

Leave a long tail at the beginning to sew a button on.

With soft green yarn,

R1: 10 sc into magic ring. Sl st to first sc to join.

R2: Ch 2, dc in same st. Ch 2, sl st in next st. *Ch 2, dc in next st, ch 2, sl st in next st* rep to end. Sl st to first dc to join. Ch 7, sl st onto the other side of the flower so this makes a chain loop behind the flower.

Fasten off and weave in the ends. Sew a button in the middle of the flower. Put the flower on one of the ears.





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
