

# To and fro 

A cabled cowl

## To and fro

## Finished dimensions

31" circumference, after blocking. 8 " height, after blocking.

Yarn
Approximately 115 yards of super-bulky yarn.
3 skeins of Blue Sky Alpacas Bulky (50\% alpaca, $50 \%$ wool, 45 yards / 100g), in Coyote.

## Needles

US \#15 (10mm) 24" circular needle.

## Notions

Cable needle.
Stitch marker to mark beginning of round.
Optionally, stitch markers to separate pattern repeats.

## Gauge

1.75 st and 4.5 rows per inch in seed stitch pattern, after blocking.

## Notes

The cowl is worked in the round, using 6 horizontal and 2 vertical repeats of the zig-zag cable design.

Below is a written version of the pattern. If you prefer charts, refer to the zig-zag cable chart. Work 6 repeats of the chart within each round, and repeat rows 1-15 of the chart a second time, casting off on the last round of the second chart repeat (round 32).


## Directions

CO 72 stitches, using the long-tail method. You will need a tail about 2.5 yards long.
To make the first row easier to work, I recommend casting on holding together your main needle and a second, thinner needle; I used a US \#4 held together with the US \#15 needle.

Place a marker and join in the round. Begin working zig-zag cable pattern as follows:
RND 1 *p, k, p, k, p, sl 1 st to cn and hold in back, $k 3$, p from cn, k, p, k; repeat from * around RND $2{ }^{*} k, p, k, p, k 5, p, k, p$; repeat from * around
RND $3{ }^{*} \mathrm{p}, \mathrm{k}, \mathrm{p}, \mathrm{k}, \mathrm{sl} 1 \mathrm{st}$ to cn and hold in back, $\mathrm{k} 3, \mathrm{k}$ from $\mathrm{cn}, \mathrm{p}, \mathrm{k}, \mathrm{p}, \mathrm{k}$; repeat from * around RND $4{ }^{*} k, p, k, p, k 3, p, k, p, k, p ; r e p e a t ~ f r o m * ~ a r o u n d ~$
RND 5 *p, $\mathrm{k}, \mathrm{p}, \mathrm{sl} 1$ st to cn and hold in back, $\mathrm{k} 3, \mathrm{p}$ from $\mathrm{cn}, \mathrm{k}, \mathrm{p}, \mathrm{k}, \mathrm{p}, \mathrm{k}$; repeat from * around RND $6{ }^{*} k, p, k 5, p, k, p, k, p ; r e p e a t ~ f r o m * ~ a r o u n d ~$
RND $7{ }^{*} \mathrm{p}, \mathrm{k}, \mathrm{sl} 1$ st to cn and hold in back, $\mathrm{k} 3, \mathrm{k}$ from $\mathrm{cn}, \mathrm{p}, \mathrm{k}, \mathrm{p}, \mathrm{k}, \mathrm{p}, \mathrm{k}$; repeat from * around RND $8{ }^{*} k, p, k 3, p, k, p, k, p, k, p ;$ repeat from * around
RND $9{ }^{*} \mathrm{p}, \mathrm{k}, \mathrm{sl} 3$ st to cn and hold in front, $\mathrm{p}, \mathrm{k} 3$ from $\mathrm{cn}, \mathrm{p}, \mathrm{k}, \mathrm{p}, \mathrm{k}, \mathrm{p}, \mathrm{k}$; repeat from * around RND 10 * k, p, k5, p, k, p, k, p; repeat from * around
RND 11 * p, k, p, sl 3 st to cn and hold in front, $\mathrm{k}, \mathrm{k} 3$ from $\mathrm{cn}, \mathrm{k}, \mathrm{p}, \mathrm{k}, \mathrm{p}, \mathrm{k}$; repeat from * around RND 12 *k, p, k, p, k3, p, k, p, k, p; repeat from* around
RND $13^{*}$ p, $\mathrm{k}, \mathrm{p}, \mathrm{k}, \mathrm{sl} 3$ st to cn and hold in front, $\mathrm{p}, \mathrm{k} 3$ from $\mathrm{cn}, \mathrm{p}, \mathrm{k}, \mathrm{p}, \mathrm{k}$; repeat from * around RND $144^{*} k, p, k, p, k 5, p, k, p$; repeat from * around
RND $155^{*} \mathrm{p}, \mathrm{k}, \mathrm{p}, \mathrm{k}, \mathrm{p}, \mathrm{sl} 3$ st to cn and hold in front, $\mathrm{k}, \mathrm{k} 3$ from $\mathrm{cn}, \mathrm{k}, \mathrm{p}, \mathrm{k}$; repeat from * around RND $16{ }^{*} k, p, k, p, k, p, k 3, p, k, p ; r e p e a t ~ f r o m * ~ a r o u n d ~$

Repeat rnds 1-15 once more, for a total of 31 rounds.
BO loosely, using an elastic method.
Weave in ends.
Wet block.

| p | purl |
| sl | slip stitch (tip to tip) |
| st | stitch |
| cn | cable needle |
| CO | cast on |
| BO | bind off |
| rnd | round |
