Absence

In memory of my grandmother, Ruth, and in honor of my uncle, Joel, and my aunt Patty.

As part of an Alzheimer's Fundraising Event (http://act.alz.org/site/TR/Walk2014/MA-MassachusettsNewHampshire?team_id=202132&pg=team&fr_id=5146)

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Materials:

- approximately 50 grams of assorted worsted weight yarn, such as Red Heart Super Saver. Scraps in 3 different colors (CC1, CC2, CC3), or as desired
- o size H (5.0 mm) crochet hook

Gauge: 12 sts=4" in pattern

Measurements: 12" square

Abbreviations (pattern uses US terms):

ch: chain

rep: repeat

sk: skip(ped)

sp: space

dc: double crochet

Pattern Note: After finishing pattern as written, if square is coming out a little small, crochet a round of sc evenly spaced across all 4 sides, working 3 sc into each corner. Blocking is highly recommended for this design. Change colors as desired.

Pattern:

Ch 40 loosely.

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Row 1: 3 dc in 5th ch from hook (sk chs count as dc), * sk next 2 chs, 3 dc in next ch. Rep from * across row until 2 chs remain, sk next ch, dc in last ch: 38 dc made.

Row 2: Ch 3, turn, dc in sp before next group of 3 dc, * sk next 3 dc, 3 dc in sp between groups of 3 dc. Rep from * across row until last sp, dc in last sp, dc in last dc: 37 dc made.

Row 3: Ch 3, turn, sk next dc, 3 dc in sp before next group of 3 dc, * sk next 3 dc, 3 dc in sp between groups of 3 dc. Rep from * across row until 2 dc remain, sk next dc, dc in last dc: 38 dc made.

Rows 4-21: Rep rows 2 and 3.

Row 22: Rep row 2.

End off. Weave in ends and block lightly.
