



Lacy Heart

Make it in cotton, and call it a scrubbie. Use a different fiber, add a tie, and call it an ornament or package tie!

Materials:

- scrap of cotton worsted weight yarn
- H crochet hook

Gauge: doesn't matter, it's a heart!

Finished measurements: approximately 2.25" across

Abbreviations (pattern uses US terms):

ch: chain

sp: space

sc: single crochet

dc: double crochet

sk: skip

group: 2 dc, ch 1, 2 dc (all in same ch sp)

Pattern:

Start with a magic loop.

Row 1: ch 1, 5 sc into loop.

Row 2: Ch 3, turn. In 1st sc, (dc, ch 1, 2 dc – counts as beg group), sk 1 sc, group in next sc, sk 1 sc, group in last sc.

Row 3: Ch 1, turn. Sc in 1st dc, ch 2, sk 1 dc, (sc, ch 3, sc) in ch 1 sp. Sk 2 dc, ch 2, sc in next sp between groups. Ch 2, sk 2 dc, (sc, ch 3, sc) in ch 1 sp. Ch 2, sk 2 dc, sc in between groups. Ch 2, sk 2 dc, (sc, ch 3, sc) in ch 1 sp. Ch 2, sk dc, & sc in 3rd ch of beg ch 3. End off, weave in ends.
