## WEAVERKNITS

## REPTILIAN



Reptilian is an elegant, easy to knit scarf that can be worked in yarn of any weight and any fiber. A simple yarn-over pattern at the edges and beads at each tail accent the primarily garter stitch fabric. Beads can be added using a crochet hook or pre-strung; if you want to avoid pushing the 25 beads for the end section of the scarf along as you knit the body, cut the yarn before beginning the end section, pre-string the 25 beads, and rejoin the yarn.

## Size

Approximately 75 inches long by 11 inches wide, after lightly steam blocking

## Skills Used

Basic yarn over pattern, beading either by pre-stringing or using a crochet hook

## Supplies

- 2.5 oz (approx. 255 yds) Habu Textiles $2 / 7$ Soft Wool (100\% wool; 109 yds/oz)
- US size $11(8.0 \mathrm{~mm})$ needles or size to obtain desired fabric
- Yarn needle for weaving in ends
- 50 size 08 seed beads
- Magic eye or threading needle for pre-stringing beads


## Gauge

14 sts and 16 rows $=4$ inches in garter st, after a light steam blocking
Gauge is unimportant for this project; experiment with yarn weigh and needle size to find a fabric that pleases you.

## Stitch Instructions

Bead 1 (b1): Hold bead to back of work ( p bump) and k st as usual.

## Simple Pattern Stitch

Row 1: K
Row 2: K1, *[yo, k1], rep from * 6 times, k to end of row.
Row 3: K2tog 6 times, $k$ to end of row.
Row 4: Rep Row 2.
Row 5: Rep Row 3.

## Instructions

## Beginning (inc rows):

Pre-string 25 beads onto yarn.
CO 1 st.
Row 1: Kbfb (3 sts)
Row 2 and all following even-numbered rows: K
Row 3: K1, yo, k1, yo, k1 (5 sts)
Row 5: K1, yo, k1, b1, k1, yo, k1 (7 sts)
Row 7: K1, yo, k1, b1, k1, b1, k1, yo, k1 (9 sts)
Cont to work yo inc and beads on odd-numbered rows in this fashion, beg each row with [k1, yo, $\mathrm{k} 1, \mathrm{~b} 1$ ], k to last 3 sts, end row [b1, k1, yo, k1]. Stop inc when there are 31 sts total, ending with an even-numbered row. All 25 beads should be incorporated.

## Body:

Beg working in the 5-row Simple Pattern Stitch, and cont until scarf measures 67 inches or about 8 inches short of desired length. End with Row 5. Cut yarn and pre-string 25 beads. Rejoin yarn to work.

## End (dec rows): The following rows will rev the shaping of the beg section.

K 1 row.
Row 1: K1, yo, k2tog, b1, k25, b1, k2tog, yo, k1
Row 2 and all following even-numbered rows: K
Row 3: K2tog, yo, k2tog, b1, k21, b1, k2tog, yo, k2tog
Cont to work dec and beads on odd-numbered rows in this fashion, beg each row with [k2tog, yo, k 2 tog, b 1 ], k to last 5 sts, end row [b1, k2tog, yo, k2tog]. Stop dec when there are 9 sts total, ending with an even-numbered row. All but 1 bead should be incorporated. The next dec row will be row 15 of the end section.

Row 15: K2tog, yo, k2tog, b1, k2tog, yo, k2tog (7 sts)
Row 17: K2tog, yo, k3tog, k2tog (5 sts)
Row 19: K3tog (1 st)
Cut yarn and draw through rem st.

Finishing
Weave in ends. Wet block as gently or firmly as you like to open the lace pattern.
