## Floppy Brimmed Hat

## Materials

Yarn according to gauge guide $30 z$ main color, small amount contrasting color
Hook size according to gauge guide
Yarn needle

Use this guide to help determine yarn and hook size depending on size wanted. Please remember that although the measurements seem small you want the hat 1 to 2 inches smaller around than the actual head measurement for a perfect fit.

| $\# 1$ | fine baby yarn | F hook | 19 sts $=4^{\prime \prime}$ | $16^{\prime \prime}$ |

| $\# 4$ | medium yarn | G hook | 13 sts $=3^{\prime \prime}$ | $17^{\prime \prime}$ |
|  |  | H hook | 16 sts $=4^{\prime \prime}$ | $19^{\prime \prime}$ |
| $\# 3$ | Baby weight yarn | G hook | 18 sts=4" | $17^{\prime \prime}$ |
|  |  | F hook | 19 sts=4" | $15^{\prime \prime}$ |

With main color
Chain 5 , sl st to form a ring
Rnd 1-Ch 3 work 14 dc in ring, slst to top of ch 3
Rnd 2-Ch 3 work dc in same space as slst, work 2dc in each dc around, slst to top of ch 3
Rnd 3-Ch 3 ( 2 dc in next dc, dc in next dc) around ending with 2 dc in last dc , slst to top of ch 3
Rnd 4-ch 3, dc in next dc ( 2 dc in next dc, dc in next 2 dc)around ending with 2 dc in last dc, slst to top of ch 3 Rnd 5-ch 3, dc in next 2 dc ( 2 dc in next dc , dc in next 3 dc ) around ending with 2 dc in last dc , slst to top of ch 3 (will have 75sts)
Rnds 6-15-ch 3 dc in each dc around, join with slst to top of ch 3

Rnd 16 - ch 3 , dc in next 2 dc ( 2 dc in next dc, dc in next 3 dc ) around ending with 2 dc in next dc, dc in last 3 dc , slst to top of ch 3
Rnd 17-ch 3, dc in next 2 dc ( 2 dc in next dc, dc in next 3 dc ) around ending with 2 dc in next dc, dc in last dc, slst to top of ch 3
Rnd 18-ch 3, dc in next 3 dc ( 2 dc in next dc, dc in next 4 dc ) around ending with 2 dc in next dc, dc in last dc, slst to top of ch 3
Rnd 19- ch 3, dc in next 4 dc ( 2 dc in next dc, dc in next 5 dc ) around ending with 2 dc in next dc, dc in last dc, slst to top of ch 3
Rnd 20- ch 3, dc in next 5 dc ( 2 dc in next dc, dc in next 6 dc ) around ending with 2 dc in next dc, dc in last dc, slst to top of ch 3
Change to contrasting color
Sc in each sc around, slst to top if first sc (will have 185 sc )
Ch $1^{*}$ sc in next 5 sc , work picot (ch 3 slst in first ch)* repeat between * around slst to top of first sc, finish off

Rose instructions (contrasting color)

## Ch 5 slst to form ring

Rnd 1-ch I (scin ring ch 3) 5 times slst to top of first ch 1
Rnd 2- ch 1, work sc, hdc, 3dc, hdc, sc in each loop around slst to top of first sc
Rnd 3-working in the back working around the post of the sc in rnd 1, ch 1 slst around post, ch 1 sc around same post, (ch 5 sc around next post) around ending ch 5 slst to top of first sc
Rnd 4-ch 1 (sc, hdc, $5 \mathrm{dc}, \mathrm{hdc}, \mathrm{sc}$ ) in each ch 5 loop around, slst to top of first sc
Rnd 5- ch 1 slst around post of sc in rnd 3, ch 1 sc around post, (ch 7 sc around next post) around ending ch 7 slst to top of first sc
Rnd 6-ch 1, (sc, hdc, 7dc, hdc, sc) in each ch 7 loop around, slst to top of first sc. Finish off.

## Leaves (make 2)

(contrasting color)
CH 11, sc in second ch from hook, hdc in next 2 ch, dc in next 6ch, 8 dc in next ch, working in free loops from ch, dc in next 6 ch , hdc in next 2 ch , sc in last ch, slst to top of first sc, slst across each hole from original chain across, finish off.

Turn brim up, sew rose on, sew on leaves putting the round end under rose.
