The Deb Scarf

This is the perfect light weight fall scarf!

It soft and cozy enough for those cooler days without the added bulk. The V stitches give it just the right fanciness to wear to a wedding or special event draped over your shoulders.





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Materials

- Yarn: 2 Colors of Light Fingerling, Patons Lace was used.
- Hook: H, 5.00mm
- Notions:

Sizing

- Gauge: 13 Stitches and 15 rows = 4"x4"
- Overall length is 60" and width is 12".
- To extend length lengthen with even numbers in the beginning chain. To widen add more V stitch rows.

Pattern Key

- Ch: Chain (for example)
- Hdc: Half Double Crochet
- Sc: Single Crochet
- Dc: Double Crochet
- Slst: Slip Stitch

Specialty Stitching

• V Stitch: 2dc between each set of 2dc from the previous row.



Pattern Instructions

With Color A (Solid Color)

- Row 1: ch 202, sc in $1^{\rm st}$ chain from hook and sc across, turn Row 2-3: ch1 sc across, turn
- Row 4-17: ch1, hdc across, turn. At the end of row 17 break yarn and weave in ends.

With Color B (Variegated Color)

- Row 18: attach yarn and ch 2, dc in 1^{st} stitch, (sk1, 2dc) to the end, turn
- Row 19-33: slst between the $1^{\rm st}$ set of dc's from the previous row, ch3, dc, V stitch to the end of the row, turn
- If you prefer a wider scarf continue with "V" stitch rows until desired width is achieved and proceed onto Row 34.
- Row 34: ch1, sc across the entire row. Break yarn and weave in ends.
