Iris Afghan Square

Size: 12 inches by 12 inches

## Skill Level: intermediate

Materials: 1 skein of Cascade 220 Superwash (may only need half of the skein to complete square). US Size 7 ( 4.5 mm ) needles OR SIZE NEEDED TO GET GAUGE.
markers
yarn needle
Gauge: 20 stitches and 28 rows per 4 inches/ 10 centimeters in stockinette stitch.

## Abbreviations: <br> k - knit

k2tog - knit 2 stitches together
p - purl
pm - place marker
s1, k2tog, psso - slip 1, knit 2 stitches together, and pass first slip stitch over the two stitches knitted together.
$\mathrm{St}(\mathrm{s})$ - $\operatorname{stitch}(\mathrm{es})$

## Stitch Patterns:

Garter Stitch - Knit every stitch/row.
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## Chart Legend:



PLEASE READ ENTIRE PATTERN BEFORE STARTING, SO AS TO NOT MISS "AT SAME TIME" DIRECTIONS AND TO PREVENT ERRORS.

## Iris Square:

Cast on 60 sts.
Knit 10 rows in garter stitch until there are 5 garter ridges on the right (public) side. End having worked a wrong side row.

Knit next 4 sts in garter stitch, pm, then knit first row of chart (see page 3) on next 52 sts, pm, knit last 4 sts in garter stitch. Continue as established until all 68 rows of the chart are completed.

Knit 10 rows in garter stitch until there are 5 garter ridges on the right side.
Bind off in pattern. Sew in ends and block square to size.


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
