Iris Afghan Square By Denise Daniel



Size: 12 inches by 12 inches

Skill Level:  INTERMEDIATE

Materials: 1 skein of Cascade 220 Superwash (may only need half of the skein to complete square).
US Size 7 (4.5mm) needles OR SIZE NEEDED TO GET GAUGE.
markers
yarn needle

Gauge: 20 stitches and 28 rows per 4 inches/10 centimeters in stockinette stitch.

Abbreviations:

k – knit

k2tog – knit 2 stitches together

p – purl

pm - place marker

s1, k2tog, psso – slip 1, knit 2 stitches together, and pass first slip stitch over the two stitches knitted together.



St(s) - stitch(es)

Stitch Patterns:

Garner Stitch - Knit every stitch/row.

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Chart Legend:

I	Knit on Right Side, Purl on Wrong Side														
	k1, p1, k1, n this stitch. *Turn work and k1, p1, k1, repeat twice from*, then s1, k2tog, pssso.														
	An empty box is Purl on Right side, Knit on Wrong Side.														

PLEASE READ ENTIRE PATTERN BEFORE STARTING, SO AS TO NOT MISS “AT SAME TIME” DIRECTIONS AND TO PREVENT ERRORS.

Iris Square:

Cast on 60 sts.

Knit 10 rows in garter stitch until there are 5 garter ridges on the right (public) side. End having worked a wrong side row.

Knit next 4 sts in garter stitch, pm, then knit first row of chart (see page 3) on next 52 sts, pm, knit last 4 sts in garter stitch. Continue as established until all 68 rows of the chart are completed.

Knit 10 rows in garter stitch until there are 5 garter ridges on the right side.

Bind off in pattern. Sew in ends and block square to size.
