

Corner Hammock for Rat



Materials: F hook and worsted weight yarn, I used Caron Simply soft

Ch 60, sc in 2nd ch from hook and every ch to end. Ch 1, turn.

Sl st in first 8 st, ch 1, sc in next 46 st. ch 1, turn.

Sc in next 45 st, ch 1, turn.

Sc2tog, sc in next 42 st, sc2tog. Ch 1, turn.

Sc2tog, sc to last to st, sc2tog. Repeat this row until there are 4 st left in your row.

Next row: sc2tog twice, ch 1, turn.

Sc2tog. Ch 1, sc around edge until you reach the first corner.

Ch 18, turn. Sl st in 12th ch from hook, then sc in each ch until you are back to corner, sl st in corner st.

Sl st around the other tab that is in the corner, then continue down the edge until you reach the next corner. Repeat * to * in this corner.

Continue sc until you reach the final corner. Since there are no tabs here, first repeat from * to * as prior corner was done, then ch 8. Sc in each ch, then sl st in corner. Tie off and weave in ends.

In each corner, you will have one tab and one looped tab. On each plain tab, sew a ½" to ¾" button. You now have an easy way to attach the hammock to a cage. This should be strong enough to hold up to rat teeth, at least for a couple of days!
