

Newborn ribbon hat



Needles- US size 6 14" straight needles

Worsted weight yarn (I used lily sugar n cream yarn cone in ecru)

Cast on 58 stitches

row 1- knit

row 2- knit

row 3- (k2tog, yo) until 2 stitches remain, k2

row 4- purl

row 5- knit

row 6- purl

row 7- k2tog repeat until end of row

row 8- kfb until last stitch, k1

row 9-knit

row 10-purl

row 11- knit

row 12-knit

row 13-knit

row 14-purl

repeat rows 13 and 14 seven times

row 29-(K7,k2tog) to end of row

row 30-purl

row 31-(k6, k2tog) to end of row

row 32-purl

row 33-(k5, k2tog) to end of row

row 34-purl

row 35-(k4, k2tog) to end of row

row 36-(p3, p2tog) to end of row

row 37-(k2, k2tog) to end of row

row 38-(p1, p2tog) to end of row

row 39-(k2tog) to end of row

At this point cut your yarn, leaving about a 2 ½ to 3 foot tail. Thread the tail through a yarn needle and thread through remaining stitches. Take off knitting needle and pull thread to cinch remaining stitches. Then, fold your hat in half inside-out and sew up the edge with your choice of stitch. Tie off and weave in ends.

Cut length of ribbon about 3 feet long and thread through the eyelets at the bottom of the hat. Tie a bow in your preferred size and trim any excess. Remember to cut the ribbon at a diagonal to help prevent unraveling. Place on the head of a newborn baby and take in the cuteness.
