Notes

Materials

- <u>varn/wool</u> in green, white, yellow
- crochet hook in fitting size
- filling
- craft eyes (no safety eyes) or embroidery floss/yarn in black
- embroidery floss/yarn in black (for mouth)
- tapestry needle, scissors, stitch marker

Skills level: easy to intermediate.

The complete figure is worked in single crochet only. For the crown also slip stitch, double crochet, and picot are needed. This pattern does not include basic crochet tutorials.

Some tips for making Amigurumis

- I recommend beginning all rounds with an adjustable ring ("Magic Ring").
 (Alternatively you can also start with 2 chains.)
- All rounds are worked in a continuous spiral; do <u>not join</u> rounds with a slip stitch, unless indicated.
- You may find it useful to use a <u>stitch</u> <u>marker</u> (e.g. a piece of yarn) for counting your rounds.
- When <u>stuffing</u> your Amigurumi (or parts of it), take care to give each part a nice shape, don't just put the filling in randomly.
- I also recommend taking your time when making (embroidering) your Amigurumi's face.



Pattern

Abbreviations

US notation

st stitchsl st slip stitchch chain

sc single crochetdc double crochet

pic picot (ch 3, sl st into base stitch)inc increase (2 sc in next stitch)

dec decrease (2 sc worked off together)

FO fasten off

Body

With green:

Round 1: 6 sc

Round 2: inc (12)

Round 3: (sc, inc) repeat around (18)

Round 4: sc (18)

Round 5: (2 sc, inc) repeat around (24)

Round 6: sc (24)

Round 7: (3 sc, inc) repeat around (30)

Round 8 – 13: sc (30)

Round 14: (3 sc, dec) repeat around (24)

Round 15: (2 sc, dec) repeat around (18)

Stuff the first part of the body.

Round 16: (sc, dec) repeat around (12)
Round 17: dec around (6) **OR** sc in every 2nd st (6)

FO, leave a long yarn tail, stuff firmly, shape the egg, weave yarn tail through front loops of last round and pull tight so that the hole is closed; weave in loose end.

Feet (make 2)

With green: ch 4

Round 1: sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc, 3 sc in next ch – continue on the other side of beginning-ch – sc, 2 sc in last ch (8)

Round 2: inc, sc, 3 inc, sc, 2 inc (14)

Round 3 - 5: sc around (14)

Round 6: dec, 3 sc, 2 dec, 3 sc, dec (10)

Round 7: dec, 3 sc, dec, 3 sc (8) Round 8 – 10: sc around (8)

Stuff front part/toes of each foot (not the whole foot); put open ends flat together and close the hole. Sew feet to the body.

Eyelids (make 2)

With green:

Round 1: 6 sc

<u>Round 2:</u> inc around (12) <u>Round 3 – 4:</u> sc around (12)

FO, leave a long yarn tail; lay aside.

Eyeballs (make 2)

With white:

Round 1: 5 sc

Round 2: inc around (10)

Round 3: sc around (10)

Round 4: dec around (5)

FO, stuff, close the hole. Put the eyeball into the eyelid (don't hesitate to get a bit tough – take the hook if needed). Use the loose ends of the eyelids to fix the eyeball in the eyelid and to attach the eyes to the head.

Crown

With **yellow**:


(also refer to the chart below)

ch 10, sl st to form ring

Round 1: ch 1, 10 sc, sl st to join round

Round 2: * ch 2, dc in next st, pic, ch 2, sl st in next st – repeat from * around (= 5 peaks)

FO, leave a long yarn tail, sew to head.



crochet chart - crown

Finishing

- Sew/glue on <u>eyes</u> or embroider them in black.
- Embroider mouth with black.
