Universal-style cap made in mesh style may be large(adult) sweet addition to the upcoming spring.



# SKILL LEVEL: easy









# SIZES

small(infant), medium(toddler), large(child), X-large(adult)

# FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

17" (44cm), 18" (46cm), 19" (48cm), 201/2" (52cm)

## **MATERIALS**

- Altin Basak Miya (100% cotton 50g (1.75oz)/134yd-125mt) in violet (MC) - 1 ball/ 2 balls
- small amount of fingering –weight yarn in pink
   (CP)
- small amount of sport-weight yarn in lime (CL)

### **CROCHET HOOKS**

C-2(2.75mm); B-1(2.25mm) or any size to obtain correct gauge

#### **NOTIONS**

optional 3-4 satin flower appliques

# **GAUGE**

first 6 rounds = 2" in diameter

#### **BODY**

**NOTE:** the cap is worked in rounds. See cap diagram on page 4.

• With MC and larger crochet hook ch 5; join with sl st to make a ring.

Rnd 1(RS): ch4, [dc, ch] 7(8, 9, 10) times; join with sl st in 3<sup>rd</sup> ch of beg ch 4.

Rnd 2: ch 4, sc in first ch-1 sp, ch 3, [sc in next ch-1 sp, ch3, sc in the same ch-1 sp] in each ch-1 sp around; join with ch 1, hdc in bottom of beg ch-4

Rnd 3: ch4, [sc in next ch-3 sp, ch 3] around to last ch-3 sp, sc in last ch-3 sp; join with ch 2, hdc in bottom of beg ch-4

Rnd 4: ch 5, [sc in next ch-3 sp, ch 4] around to

last ch-3 sp, sc in last ch-3 sp; join with ch 2, hdc in bottom of beg ch-5

Rnd 5: ch1, sc across hdc just made, [ch4, 2 sc in next ch-4 sp] around to last ch-4 sp; join with ch 2, hdc in first sc

Rnd 6: ch 1, sc across hdc just made, [ch 5, 2 sc in next ch-5 sp] around to last ch-4 sp; join with ch 2, hdc in first sc

Rnd 7: ch 1, sc across hdc just made, ch 6, 2 sc in next ch-5 sp, [ch 5, 2 sc in next ch-5 sp] around to last ch-5 sp; join with ch 2, hdc in first sc

**NOTE:** if you crocheting looser ch 5 except first ch 6 of rnd 7

Rnd 8 - Rnds 23 (24, 25, 26): ch 1, 2 sc across hdc just made, ch 6, 3 sc in next ch-6 sp, [ch 5, 3 sc in next ch-5 sp] around to last ch-5 sp; join with ch 2, hdc in first sc

Rnd 24 (25, 26, 27): ch1, 2 sc across hdc just made, [ch 3, 3 sc in next ch-5 sp] around to last ch-5, ch 3; join with sl st in ch-1

Rnd 25 (26, 27, 28): ch 4, sc in next sc, [4 sc in next ch-3 sp, sc, picot, sc] around to last ch-3 sp, 4sc in next ch-3 sc; join with sl st to beg ch-1. Fasten off.

#### **FLOWERS**

NOTE: see flower diagram on page 4.

• With CP and smaller crochet hook ch 2, 5 sc in 2<sup>nd</sup> ch from hook.

Rnd 1: [ch 3, 2 dc in the same sc, ch 3 sl st in the same sc, sl st in next sc] 5 times. Fasten off, leaving about 10" (15cm) yarn tail.

• Make 2<sup>nd</sup> flower with CL and larger crochet hook.


#### **FINISHING**

• With RS of cap, threa yarn needle with yarn tail and sew flowers (smaller on top) in bottom of a cap. Sew satin flowers appliques. Wave in ends.


#### **ABBREVIATIONS**

beg – beginning
ch – chain
sc – single crochet
hdc – half double crochet
dc – double crochet
sl st - slip stitch
RS – right side
sp - space
picot – (ch 3, sc in 3<sup>rd</sup> ch from
hook)
Rnd(s) – round(s)

[] – work directions in brackets
the number of time specified
