Eidothea Scarf

This is a pretty, wavy scarf inspired by a hat I saw in FatFace one day.

Yarn used: Araucania Toconao (or any Aran weight yarn) – approximately 125-130g

5mm needles

Tension: 19 stitches and 28 rows of stocking stitch = 10cm²

Pattern:

Cast on 30 stitches.

Row 1: Knit Row 2: Purl Row 3: P1, P2tog, P1, P2tog, P1, YO, K1, YO, K1, YO, K1, YO, P1, P2tog x 4, P1, YO, K1, YO, K1, YO, K1, YO, P1, P2tog, P1, P2tog, P1 Row 4, P5, K7, P6, K7, P5 Row 5: Knit Row 6: Purl Row 7: Knit Row 8: Purl

Repeat Rows 3-8 x 35 times. Then repeat rows 1-4 once and cast off on the 5^{th} row.

Nb/ Row 3 - to YO between a knit and a purl stitch bring the yarn forward to the front of the work and then wrap it back over the needle once before making the purl stitch.
