

Cable Curtain Tie Backs



With your crochet hook, chain 18 stitches and place last single stitch on your knitting needle

Beginning Wedge

Row 1: Kfb, turn (2 sts)

Row 2: K1, K first st of tail, to make a loop, K1, turn (3 sts)

Row 3: Kfb, K1, Kfb, turn (5 sts)

Row 4: Kfb, K to last st, Kfb, turn

Repeat Row 4 until 15 sts total

(WS) K across, turn — if this row is needed

Main Section

RS: K2, P1, PM, [Braided Cable Pattern (odd rows)], PM, P1, K2

WS: K2, K1, SM [Braided Cable Pattern (even rows)], SM, K1, K2

Repeat until desired length.

End Wedge

(RS) K across, turn

(WS) K2tog, knit to last 2 sts, K2tog, turn

Repeat last row, until 3 sts remain, then SKP leaving 1 st

With your crochet hook, chain 18 stitches from last remaining stitch and BO. Use the tail and darning needle to secure the end around into a loop.

Weave in and trim all ends.



Materials Needed:

- <1 ball of Lion Cotton
- Crochet Hook
- US 8 Needles
- Darning Needle
- Stitch Markers

Abbreviations

K knit **P** purl

Kfb knit in front and back of the stitch (increase)

PM place marker

SM slip marker

T3F - Twist 3 Front

Slip next two sts onto a cable needle and hold at front of work, purl next st from the left-hand needle, then knit sts from cable needle

T3B - Twist 3 Back

Slip next st on a cable needle and hold at back of work, knit next 2 sts from left-hand needles, then purl st from cable needle

C4F/C4B - Cable 4 Front (Back)

Slip next 2 sts onto a cable needle and hold at front (or back) of work, knit next 2 sts from left-hand needle then knit sts from cable needle

K2tog Knit 2 together

SKP Slip 2 sts, knit next st, pass slipped sts over knit st (double decrease)

Braided Cable Pattern

(from The Harmony Guides 450 Knitting Stitches Volume 2, page 78)

Worked over 9 stitches

1st row: T3F, T3B, T3F

2nd row: P2, K2, P4, K1

3rd row: P1, C4B, P2, K2

4th row: as 2nd row

5th row: T3B, T3F, T3B

6th row: K1, P4, K2, P2

7th row: K2, P2, C4F, P1

8th row: as 6th row

Repeat these 8 rows.
