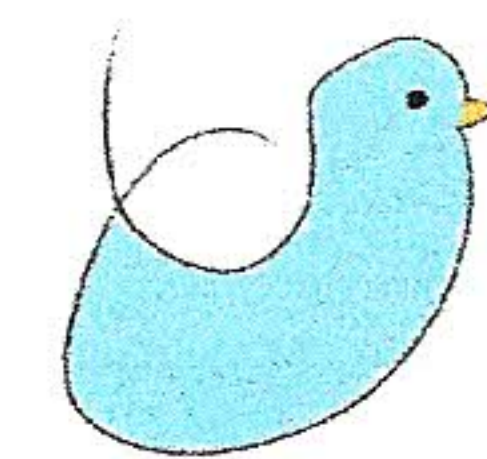


Be Happy Knits

Striped Kitchen Rug

Materials

Yarn: Red Heart Super Saver

Color A—Black

Color B—Olympic Blue

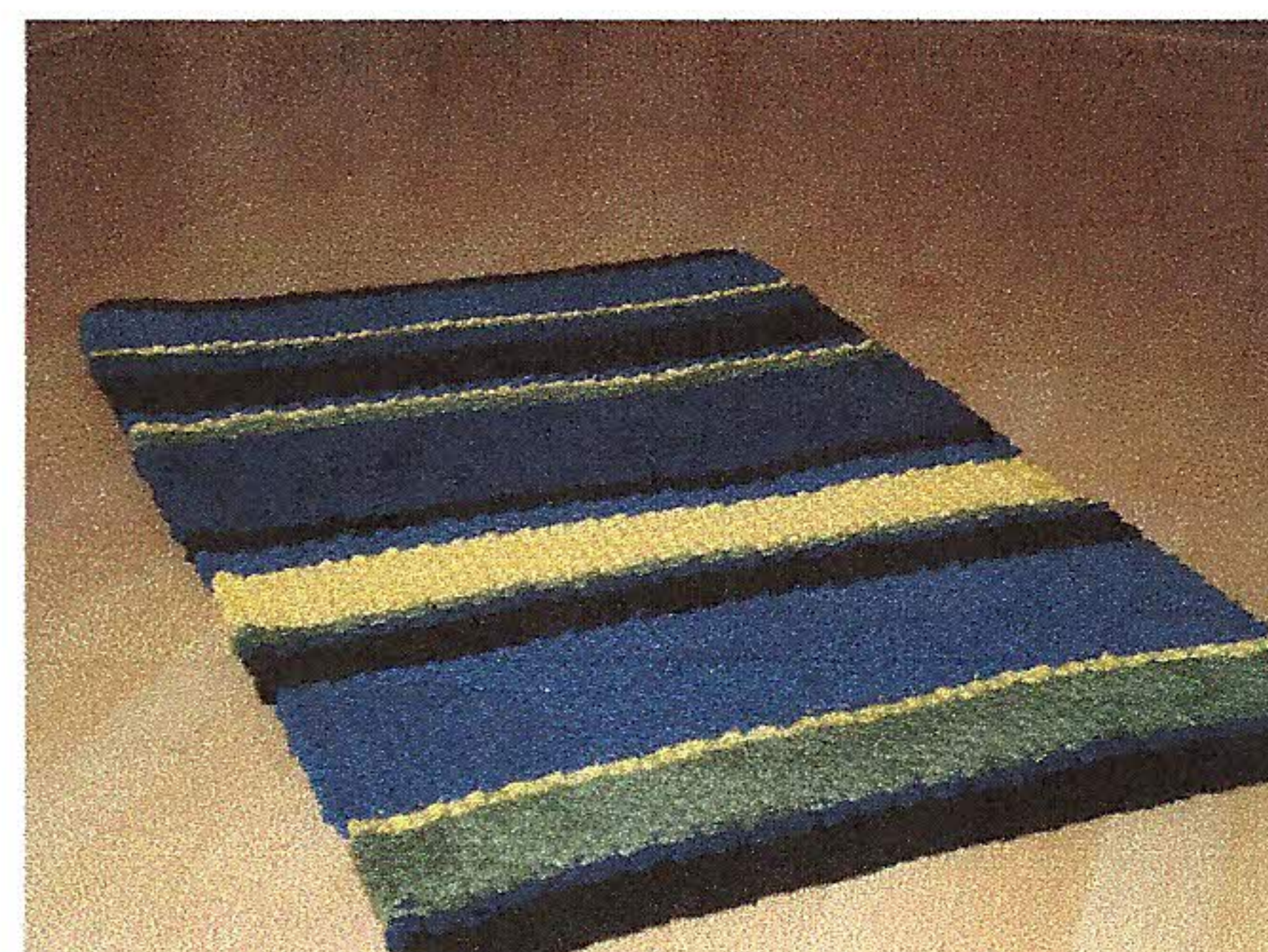
Color C—Yellow

Color D—Pale Sage

Color E—Soft Navy

Three skeins of each color eliminates the need to roll separate balls for each stripe as three strands together are needed; however only one skein per color is needed

Needles: Size 13 (9mm) circular needles or size needed to obtain gauge



Stitch Pattern: Seed Stitch. Using three strands of yarn together Knit, Purl, (*Knit, Purl), repeat from star to last stitch, K. Repeat pattern for each row. (Knit the Purl Stitches and Purl the Knit stitches.)

Gauge: Use Three strands together in Seed Stitch. 10 stitches and 15 rows = 4 inches/10cm.

Use three strands together and Cast on 53 stitches in Color A. Begin working in seed stitch across. Color A—three rows. Change to color B. Cut yarn when changing colors, do not carry across the back.

Color B—12 rows. Change to color C.

Color C—2 rows. Change to color D.

Color D—2 rows. Change to Color E.

Color E—6 rows.

Color A—12 rows

Color B—2 Rows.

Color C—two rows

Color D—4 rows.

Color E—22 rows

Color A—4 rows

Color B—4 Rows

Color C—12 rows

Color D—two rows

Color E—two rows

Color A—6 rows

Color B—20 rows

Color C—two rows

Color D—10 rows

Color E—2 rows

Color A—5 rows.

Bind off following row in pattern; Weave in loose ends on back side of rug. Block as needed to dimensions.



Finished Dimensions: 25 inches x 37 inches
