Trimetime Hat

Knit <u>Primetime</u> in an evening of watching your favorite shows. It knits up quickly in the round, using ribbing and a simple eyelet lace pattern. It's available in 2 sizes, average slouch and super slouch. (Shown in super slouch.) . Even though <u>Primetime</u> has a lace pattern, the fabric is still dense and warm due to the doubled yarn.

This can be worn back on the head for a fun, slouchy look, or with the brim folded up for an extra layer of warmth It's also reversible.

Materials:

Sz 10.5 circ ndl, and dpns (Or sizes needed to obtain gauge)
1 ball *Caron Simply Soft. 315 yds, 6*oz, worsted weight

Gauge: 3sts/6 rows = 1" in 2x2 rib

with yarn held doubled

Size: 20", 22" around bottom of hat with the ribbing slightly stretched. It will stretch to fit most adult heads.

<u>Skills needed:</u> Cast on, knit, purl, yarn over, knit 2 together.

Pattern stitches:

eyelet rib:

row 1&2 – K3, P2 around **row 3** – *K1, YO, K2TOG, p2* around

2x2 rib:

All rows: k2, p2 around

Directions:

CO 60, 64 sts

Place marker and join for working in the round.

Work 2x2 rib around for 8 rows.

Next row: Knit. Next row: Purl. Next row: Knit.

Next row (Set up row) *k1, YO, k1, p2* around to marker. (75, 80 sts)

Next row: Begin eyelet rib pattern.

Work eyelet rib 12 times.

Start decreases on row 2 of 13th repeat as follows, switching to dpns when necessary:

row 1 (Dec row 1) p2tog, k3 around (60 stitches)

row 2 p1, k1, yo, k2tog around

row 3 (Dec row 2) p1, k1, k2tog around

row 4 p1, k2 around

row 5 (Dec row 3) p1, k2tog, around

row 6 k2tog around

row 7 k2tog around

cut yarn and thread through remaining sts and pull tight. weave in ends.

Definitions:

K2TOG – Knit the next 2 stitches together as if they are one; 1 stitch decreased **YO** – Wrap yarn around needle from front to back; 1 stitch increased

K- Knit

P - Purl

CO - Cast On

STS - Stitches
