
keep me warm cowl

Yarn: Approximately 430 yards of worsted/aran weight yarn. I used 2 skeins of Malabrigo Worsted in Jewel Blue.

Needles: Size 10.5US circulars- lengths 16" and 24".

Other: Darning Needle, Stitch Marker

Gauge: 3.5 sts/inch stockinette

Finished Measurements: Top circumference: 23";

The keep me warm cowl was created in preparation for this year's winter. Last year, I was caught unprepared and had to resort to the layering of multiple knitted garments- and looking super bulky-which is not very attractive! I designed this quasi-cowl to allow for no air seepage between your scarf/cowl and coat! I hope it keeps you warm!

Pattern:

Cast on 80 stitches and join for working in the round, careful not to twist!

Rounds 1, 3, 5: Knit

Rounds 2, 4, 6: Purl

Round 7: Kf&b of each stitch

Rounds, 8-12: Knit

Round 13: K2tog around

Rounds 14, 16, 18: Purl

Rounds 15, 17: Knit

Repeat Rounds 7-18 three more times.

Shoulder increases:

Round 1:: Kf&b around

Rounds 2, 3: Knit

Round 4: *K1, Kf&b*- repeat around

Rounds 5-6: Knit

Round 7: K2tog around

Rounds 8, 10, 12: Purl

Rounds 9, 11: Knit

Repeat rounds 1-12 twice more, but binding off for the last purl row. I bound off by knitting, not purling. Weave in ends and enjoy!

Hopefully no air seepage for you!
