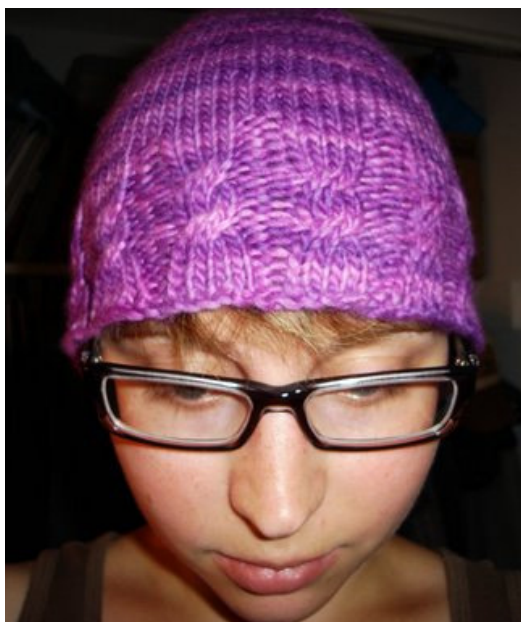


cable twist hat

Add this fast hat project to your fall queue! This hat would make a lovely, quick gift for anyone on your list!

Materials:

-Approximately 150 yards of Worsted/Aran yarn. Malabrigo Merino Worsted in Polygala used in picture.
-Size US7 16" circular needle and US7 dpns.
-Cable needle, 1 stitch marker, and tapestry needle.

Gauge: 5sts/inch in stockinette

Size: fits up to 22" head

Pattern:

Cast on 84 stitches and join to work in the round, making sure they are not twisted around the needle as you do so. Please place a marker to indicate beginning of round.

Rounds 1-6: *K4, P2*- repeat around

Round 7: *C4B (slip 2 stitches onto cable needle and hold in back, K2, then K2 from cable needle), P2*- repeat around

Rounds 8-12: *K4, P2*- repeat around

Round 13: *C4B, P2*- repeat around

Rounds 14-19: *K4, P2*- repeat around

Now begin working in stockinette stitch until hat measures approximately 6 inches from cast on edge.

Begin crown decreases:

Round 1: *K12, K2tog* around

Round 2: *K11, K2tog* around

Round 3: *K10, K2tog* around

Round 4: *K9, K2tog* around

Round 5: *K8, K2tog* around

Round 6: *K7, K2tog* around

Round 7: *K6, K2tog* around

Round 8: *K5, K2tog* around

Round 9: *K4, K2tog* around

Round 10: *K3, K2tog* around

Round 11: *K2, K2tog* around

Finishing: Cut a 6" tail and weave through remaining stitches with tapestry needle. Weave in ends and block. Enjoy!
