



Understory Cowl

Designed exclusively for The Wool Dispensary.
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Materials:

US 10, 16" or 24" circular needles, or size needed to attain gauge

2 skeins of The Wool Dispensary Imperial Poison (shown in Tightrope)

Approximately 1.5 skeins used for this pattern.

1 Stitch Marker

Tapestry Needle

Gauge (After Blocking):

16 sts = 4" in 1x1 rib stitch and Fir Cone Lace stitch

Finished Measurements (After Blocking):

32" circumference; 13.5" height

Fir Cone Lace Pattern (Multiple of 12 + 1):

Round 1: p1, *p3, k5, p4; rep from * to end

Rounds 2, 4, 6 & 8: knit

Round 3: p2tog, *p2, k2, yo, k1, yo, k2, p2, p3tog; rep from * ending with p2tog on last repeat

Round 5: p2tog, *p1, k2, yo, k3, yo, k2, p1, p3tog; rep from * ending with p2tog on last repeat

Round 7: p2tog, *k2, yo, k5, yo, k2, p3tog; rep from * ending with p2tog on last repeat

Directions:

Long tail cast on 132 sts. Place marker and join for working in the round, being careful not to twist.

Work in k1, p1 ribbing for 2 inches. On last round of ribbing, work a kfb increase in the second to last stitch. You should now have 133 sts.

Begin working the 8 round Fir Cone Lace Pattern for a total of 7 full repeats (56 rounds total).

Knit the last 2 sts together in the final 8th round. You should now have 132 sts.

Work in k1, p1 ribbing for 2 inches. Bind off purlwise.

Weave in ends, block and enjoy!
