FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Laying flat after blocking: 14"x4"

MATERIALS

Needles:

1 set of US 10 6mm double pointed needles 1 set of US 9 5.5mm double pointed needles

Notions:

Tapestry Needle

Stitch marker


Stitch holder or piece of scrap yarn.

Yarn:

Fleece Artist Shiba [70% merino, 30% Silk] 153yd/140m per 100g skein]; 1 skein

GAUGE

16 sts= 4" in stockinette stitch on US 10 needles



ABBREVIATIONS USED:

CO- cast on SSK- slip, slip, knit 2 together

STS- stitches K2TOG- knit 2 together

M 1- make 1 YO- yarn over BO- Bind Off PM- place marker

PU- Pick Up DPNs- double pointed needles

Pattern Panel: worked over 13 STS:

Row 1: (P1, K1) 2 times, K2TOG, YO, P1, YO, SSK, (K1, P1) 2 times

Row 2: K1, (P1, K4) 2 times, P1, K1

Row 3: P1, K1, P1, K2TOG, YO, K1, P1, K1, YO, SSK, P1,

K₁. P₁

Row 4: K1 (P1, K4) 2 times, P1, K1



PATTERN

Left Fingerless Glove:

Using size 9 DPNs CO 30 STS, PM and join into the round being careful not to twist STS.

Cuff: (K1,P1) around until piece measures 2".

Switch to size 10 DPNs and knit as follows:

Body:

Round 1: K4, Work Row 1 of pattern panel over next 13 sts, K to the end of the round.

Round 2: K4, Work Row 2 of pattern panel over next 13 sts, K to the end of the round.

Round 3: K4, Work Row 3 of pattern panel over next 13 sts, K to the end of the round.

Round 4: K4, Work Row 4 of pattern panel over next 13 sts, K to the end of the round.

Repeat Rounds 1-4 until piece measures 8", ending with a Round 4.

Thumb Increase:

Increase Round 1: K1, M1, K2, M1, K1, Work Row 1 of pattern panel over next 13 sts, K to the end of the round. - 2 STS increased

Increase Round 2: K6, Work Row 2 of pattern panel over next 13 sts, K to the end of the round.

Increase Round 3: K2, M1, K2, M1, K2, Work Row 3 of pattern panel over next 13 sts, K to the end of the round. -2 STS increased

Increase Round 4: K8, Work Row 4 of pattern panel over next 13 sts, K to the end of the round.

Increase Round 5: K3, M1, K2, M1, K3, Work Row 1 of pattern panel over next 13 sts, K to the end of the round. - 2 STS increased.

Increase Round 6: K10, Work Row 2 of pattern panel over next 13 sts, K to the end of the round.

Top of Hand:

Round 1: K1, place next 8 STS on a holder or scrap yarn, K1, Work Row 3 of pattern panel over next 13 sts, K to the end of the round. - 28 STS remaining on the needles.

Round 2: K2, Work Row 4 of pattern panel over next 13 sts, K to the end of the round.

Round 3: K2, Work Row 1 of pattern panel over next 13 sts. K to the end of the round.

Round 4: K2, Work Row 2 of pattern panel over next 13 sts, K to the end of the round.

Round 5: K2, Work Row 3 of pattern panel over next 13 sts, K to the end of the round.

Round 6: K2, Work Row 4 of pattern panel over next 13 sts, K to the end of the round.

Repeat Rounds 3-6 until piece measures 1.5" from thumbhole opening, ending with a Round 6.

Switch to size 9 DPNs.

Top Cuff: (K1,P1) around until ribbing measures 1.5" BO all STS loosely.

Thumb:

Using size 9 DPNs PU 8 STS from holder and 2 STS where the thumb joins the body (10 STS total), PM. Attach yarn and work (K1,P1) around for 1". BO all sts loosely.



Right Fingerless Glove:

Using size 9 DPNs CO 30 STS, PM and join into the round being careful not to twist STS.

Cuff: (K1,P1) around until piece measures 2".

Switch to size 10 DPNs and knit as follows:

Body:

Round 1: K13, Work Row 1 of pattern panel over next 13 sts, K4.

Round 2: K13, Work Row 2 of pattern panel over next 13 sts, K4.

Round 3: K13, Work Row 3 of pattern panel over next 13 sts, K4.

Round 4: K13, Work Row 4 of pattern panel over next 13 sts, K4.

Repeat Rounds 1-4 until piece measures 8", ending with a Round 4.

Thumb Increase:

Increase Round 1:, K13, Work Row 1 of pattern panel over next 13 sts, K1, M1, K2, M1, K1. - 2 STS increased **Increase Round 2:** K13, Work Row 2 of pattern panel over next 13 sts, K6.

Increase Round 3: K13, Work Row 3 of pattern panel over next 13 sts, K2, M1, K2, M1, K2. -2 STS increased **Increase Round 4:** K13, Work Row 4 of pattern panel over next 13 sts, K8.

Increase Round 5: K13, Work Row 1 of pattern panel over next 13 sts, K3, M1, K2, M1, K3. - 2 STS increased. **Increase Round 6:** K13, Work Row 2 of pattern panel over next 13 sts, K 10.

Top of Hand:

Round 1: K13, Work Row 3 of pattern panel over next 13 sts, K1, place next 8 STS on a holder or scrap yarn, K1. - 28 STS remaining on the needles.

Round 2: K13, Work Row 4 of pattern panel over next 13 sts, K2.

Round 3: K13, Work Row 1 of pattern panel over next 13 sts, K2.

Round 4: K13, Work Row 2 of pattern panel over next 13 sts, K2.

Round 5: K13, Work Row 3 of pattern panel over next 13 sts, K2.

Round 6: K13, Work Row 4 of pattern panel over next 13 sts, K2.

Repeat Rounds 3-6 until piece measures 1.5" from thumbhole opening, ending with a Round 6.

Switch to size 9 DPNs.

Top Cuff: (K1,P1) around until ribbing measures 1.5" BO all STS loosely.

Thumb:

Using size 9 DPNs PU 8 STS from holder and 2 STS where the thumb joins the body (10 STS total), PM. Attach yarn and work (K1,P1) around for 1". BO all sts loosely.

FINISHING

Weave in ends and block as desired.

Tip: If you notice that your gloves slouch or stretch with wear, sew clear elastic thread (found in the jewelry section in a craft store) all the way around the inside of the cuffs, making sure that the elastic tightens the cuff to fit snuggly on your forearms.

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
