

Multicolor Baby Hat and Mittens

Note:

For this project I used small sized needles (manufacturer recommends size #10), because I like to make very dense hats and booties/slippers for small babies. This set includes booties, which the original and simpler version of my bootie pattern can be found on my blog [HERE](#).

**Materials:**

Yarn – Red Heart Boutique Treasure (Acrylic/wool blend), color “Tapestry”
 long needles #5
 6 double pointed needles #5
 hook #E
 scissors

Abbreviations:

CO – cast on
 K – knit
 DPN – double pointed needles
 K2tog – knit two stitches together
 RS – right side
 St(s) – stitch(es)
 sl st – slip stitch
 BO – bind off

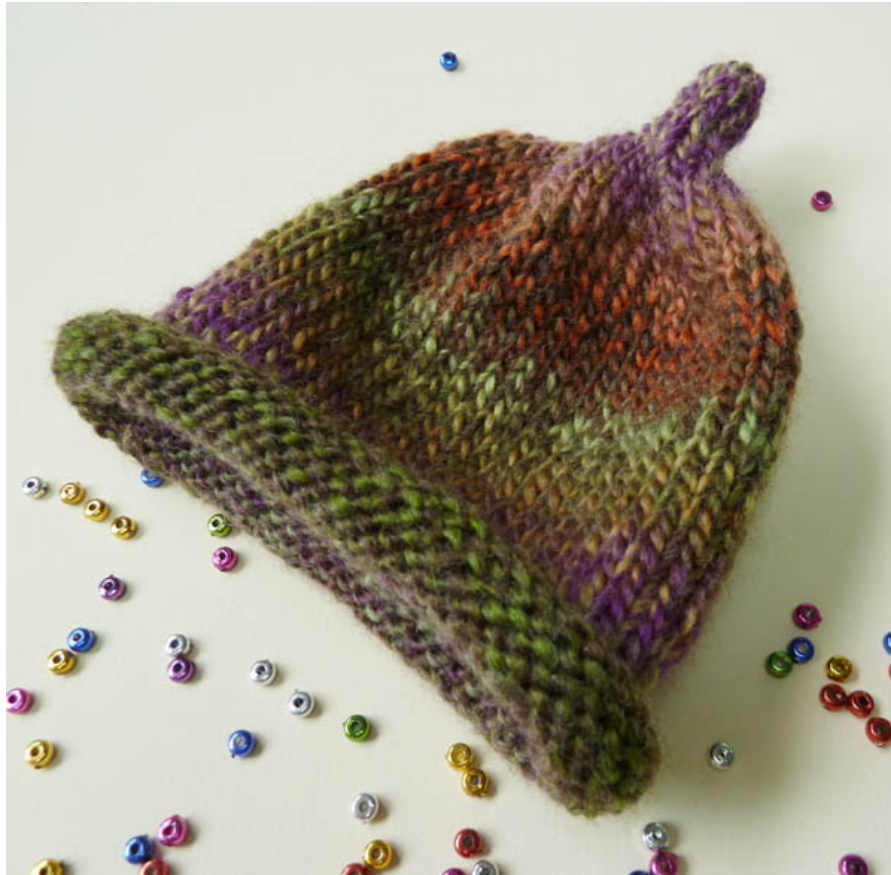
Size:

Newborn – 3 mos. (hat circumference 12 in, hat height 7 in)

Gauge:

2in x 2in = 10 sts x 13 rows

Hat



Step-by-step instructions:

- Row 1 CO 55 sts
- Row 2 K55, divide the knit between 3 DPN, connect into a circle without twisting a knit
- Row 3-38 K55 in each row
- Row 39 divide the stitches between 5 DPN (11 sts on each), *[K2tog, K9] – repeat 4 more times on each DPN
- Row 40 divide the stitches between 5 DPN (11 sts on each), *[K2tog, K8] – repeat 4 more times on each DPN
- Row 41 divide the stitches between 5 DPN (11 sts on each), *[K2tog, K7] – repeat 4 more times on each DPN
- Row 42 divide the stitches between 5 DPN (11 sts on each), *[K2tog, K6] – repeat 4 more times on each DPN
- Row 43 divide the stitches between 5 DPN (11 sts on each), *[K2tog, K5] – repeat 4 more times on each DPN
- Row 44 divide the stitches between 5 DPN (11 sts on each), *[K2tog, K4] – repeat 4 more times on each DPN

- Row 45 divide the stitches between 5 DPN (11 sts on each), *[K2tog, K3] – repeat 4 more times on each DPN
- Row 46 divide the stitches between 5 DPN (11 sts on each), *[K2tog, K2] – repeat 4 more times on each DPN
- Row 47 divide the stitches between 5 DPN (11 sts on each), *[K2tog, K1] – repeat 4 more times on each DPN
- Row 48-55 K10 in each row
- Row 56 *[K2tog] on each DPN until you have 5 sts
- Row 57 transfer sts onto a hook, pull the yarn through all of 5 sts, do a last sl st (= BO). Pull the yarn inside the hat and clean up both yarn tails (ends).



Mittens



Step-by-step insrtuctions:

- Row 1 CO 24 sts
- Row 2 K24, divide the knit between 3 DPN (8 sts on each needle), connect into a circle without twisting a knit
- Row 3-6 K24 in each row
- Row 7-13 *[K, P] – repeat entire row for 13 rows
- Row 14-31 K24
- Row 32 *[K2tog, K6] repeat on each DPN
- Row 33 *[K2tog, K5] repeat on each DPN
- Row 34 *[K2tog, K4] repeat on each DPN
- Row 35 *[K2tog, K3] repeat on each DPN

Row 36 *[K2tog, K2] repeat on each DPN
 Row 37 transfer all stitches onto your hook and pull the yarn through all 9 sts (=BO);
 make one last sl st; pull the yarn inside the glove and clean both ends (tails)

Make one more mitten.
