BABY COCOON

Materials:

I used Caron Simply Soft yarn – but you can choose similar soft medium thick yarn of your choice long needles #8 5 double pointed needles #8 hook #E scissors

Abreviations:

CO – cast on K – knit P – purl DPN – double pointed needles WS – wrong side sl first st – slip first stitch TBL – through the back loop(s) K2tog – knit two stitches together st(s) – stitch(es) BO – bind off

Size:

Newborn – 3 mos. (hat circumference 14 in., hat length is 16 and ½ in with rolled up edge)

Gauge:

 $2in \ge 2in = 8 \text{ sts } \ge 10 \text{ rows}$



Step-by-Step Instructions:

Double the yarn with two different colors – I used light steely blue and white together



Side view of a cocoon

Row 1	CO 70 sts, divide stitches evenly on 4 DPN = each will have 18-18-17-17 sts respectively, (or use your circular needles, but you will have to count your stitches while working on the top part), and without twisting connect into a circle
Row 2-7	K70
Row 8	K36, and then turn your knit around to see its wrong side
Row 9	(knit on WS) sl first st, P35, turn your knit around to see right side
Row 10	sl first st, K34; with the 3 rd DPN pick (add) an extra stitch between the needles and K2tog, K34
Row 11	with the 1 st DPN pick (add) a stitch between the needles and K2tog TBL, K69
Row 12	K70

Row 13	same as Row 8
Row 14	same as Row 9
Row 15	same as Row 10
Row 16	same as Row 11
Row 17	K70
Row 18	same as Row 8
Row 19	same as Row 9
Row 20	same as Row 10
Row 21	same as Row 11
Row 22	K70
Row 23	same as Row 8
Row 24	same as Row 9
Row 25	same as Row 10
Row 26	same as Row 11
Row 27	K70
Row 28	same as Row 8
Row 29	same as Row 9
Row 30	same as Row 9
Row 30	same as Row 10
Row 32	K70
Row 33	same as Row 8
Row 34	same as Row 9

	either a pompom or a tassel made from the same yarn. Clean up all the
	loose ends/tails.
