KNITTED BLACK AND WHITE HAT FOR MEN

Material:

- Any worsted wool (or yarn of your choice) I used Full o'Sheep, black and white colors (or choose your favorite colors)
- regular long needles #8
- 5 double pointed needles #8 (or circular needles if you prefer those)
- hook #E (3.50 mm)
- scissors

Abbreviations:

BLK - black color wool

WHT – white color wool

CO - Cast On

DPN – Double Pointed Needles

K - knit

P - purl

 $sl\ st(s) - slip\ stitch(es)$

BO – Bind Off

Size: 22 inches



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Step-by-Step Instructions:

Row 1 (BLK) CO 90 sts

Row2 (BLK) K90on regular long needles – distribute sts between 4 DPN

such as 22-24-22-24 and without twisting your knit place the needles

in the circle

Row 3-12 (BLK) *[K,P] – repeat from * entire row

Below is a detail of the design – alternating 3 white rows with 5 black rows including sl sts



Row 13 (WHT) *[K4, sl st(BLK)] – repeat from * entire row

Row 14-15 (WHT) K90

Row 16 (BLK) *[K4, sl st(WHT)] – repeat from * entire row

Row17-20 (BLK) K90

Row 21 (WHT) *[K4, sl st(BLK)] – repeat from * entire row

           (BLK) *[K4, sl st(WHT)] – repeat from * entire row

           (BLK) *[K4, sl st(WHT)] – repeat from * entire row
Row 48
Row49-56
           (BLK) K90

           BO
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Next step – create 3 corners on the top of your hat:

- 1. Fold the hat in half, line up back and front sts against each other and crochet 15 sts from back and 15 sts from front together.
- 2. Then count next 30 stitches, line up 1st and 30th stitch against each other and crochet them together. Then continue stitching 2nd and 29th sts, 3rd and 28th And so on until you are finished with second hat corner.
- 3. Finish 3rd corner by lining up last 30 sts against each other (= 15 sts in the front and 15 sts in the back), and crochet the last 15 sts together
- 4. Clean up any loose ends
