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## SUMMER BOWS HAT

## Difficulty Level:

- Easy/Intermediate


## Size:

- One Size (women's small/medium)


## Materials:

- Lily Sugar'n Cream Cotton - 2-3 balls in Natural (I used a cone that was in my stash, so I'm not exactly sure how much I actually used)
- 5.00 mm Hook


## Gauge:

- 7 st \& 4 rows in Double Crochet $=2$ inches


## Stitch Glossary:

- Slst: Slip Stitch
- Ch: Chain
- Sc: Single Crochet
- Dc: Double Crochet
- $\operatorname{St}(\mathrm{s}): \operatorname{stitch}(\mathrm{es})$


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This pattern uses the Adjustable Magic Ring to start. For a good tutorial, check out the one at petalstopicots.com:

## Instructions:

Note: hat is worked in rounds without turning, right side always facing.

Rnd 1: using the Adjustable Magic Ring, ch2 (does not count as stitch), make 14 dc in ring, pull ring tight, slst in 1 st dc.

Rnd 2: ch3 (counts as 1st stitch), dc in same st as the ch3, 2 dc in next st and in each st around (28sts), slst in top of ch3.

Rnd 3: ch3 (counts as 1st stitch), dc in same st as the ch3, dc in next st, [2dc in next st, dc in next st] around (42sts), slst in top of ch3.

Rnd 4: ch3 (counts as 1st stitch), dc in same st as the ch3, dc in the next 2 sts, [2dcin next st, dc in next 2 sts] around (56sts), slst in top on ch3.

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Rnd 5: ch3 (counts as 1st stitch), dc in each st around (56sts), slst in top of ch3.

Rnd 6: ch3 (counts as 1st stitch), dc in same st as the ch3, dc in the next 3 sts, [ 2 dc in next st, dc in next 3 sts ] around (70sts), slst in top of ch3.

Rnds 7-13: ch3 (counts as 1st stitch), dc in each st around (70sts), slst in top of ch3.

Rnds 14-15: ch1, sc in same st as ch1, sc in next 4 sts, ch5, skip 5 sts, [sc in next 5 sts, ch5, skip 5 sts] around ( $35 \mathrm{sc}, 7 \mathrm{ch}$ spaces), slst in 1st sc.

Rnd 16: ch1, sc in same st as ch1, sc in next 4 sts, ch2, sc around the 2 previous ch 5 together, ch2, skip 5 sts, [sc in next 5 st, ch2, sc around the 2 previous ch5 together, ch2, skip 5 sts] around (35sc, 7 "bows"), slst in 1st sc.

Rnd 17: ch1, sc in same st as ch1, sc in next 4 sts, ch5, skip 5 sts, [sc in next 5 sts, ch5, skip 5 sts] around ( 35 sc , 7 ch spaces), slst in 1 st sc.

Rnd 18: sc in same st as ch1, sc in each sc and ch around, (70sts), slst in 1st sc.

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Rnd 19: ch3 (counts as 1st stitch), dc in same st as the ch3, dc in the next 4 sts, [2dc in next st, dc in next 4 sts] around (84sts), slst in top of ch3.

Rnd 20: ch3 (counts as 1st stitch), dc in same st as the ch5, dc in the next 5 sts, [2dc in next st, dc in next 5 sts] around (98sts), slst in top of ch3.

Rnd 21: ch3 (counts as 1st stitch), dc in same st as the ch3, dc in the next 6 sts, [2dc in next st, dc in next 6 sts] around (112sts), slst in top of ch3.

Rnd 22: ch3 (counts as 1st stitch), dc in same st as the ch3, dc in the next 7 sts , [2dc in next st, dc in next 7 sts ] around (126sts), slst in top of ch3.

You can finish off here, or for a wider, floppier brim, continue:
Rnd 23: ch3 (counts as 1st stitch), dc in same st as the ch3, dc in the next 8 sts, [2dc in next st, dc in next 8 sts] around (140sts), slst in top of ch3.

Rnd 24: ch3 (counts as 1st stitch), dc in same st as the ch3, dc in the next 9 sts, [2dc in next st, dc in next 9 sts] around (154sts), slst in top of ch3.

Finish off and weave in ends.

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
