MidWinter Wanderer is a wonderfully versatile, wearable and chic cowl/hood. It can be easily paired with outerwear to keep the wind and snow at bay, as well as draped artfully around your shoulders as an indoor capelet/poncho accessory!

Sizes

One size; dimensions can be found in garment schematic below

Needles

4.5 mm & 5 mm circulars
(both at least 16" long)

Abbreviations

k: knit	st/sts: stitch/stitches
p: purl	inc: increase
sm: slip marker	dec: decrease
RS: right side	WS: wrong side
cn: cable needle	pm: place marker
k2tog: knit 2 together	

Yarn

Noro Silk Garden, 4.5 hanks (shown in colourway 269)

Gauge

4 sts = 1" in stockinette on 5 mm
Gauge is not crucial on this knit

Special Skills

Short rows, picking up stitches, knitting in the round, cables

Set up for Chart

- Using 4.5 mm needles, cast on 110 sts.
- Being careful not to twist sts, pm and join for working in the round.
- Work in 1x1 ribbing for 1".
- Switch to 5mm needles and work two rounds in reverse stockinette (that is, purl all the sts).
- Next round: P55, [kfb] twice into 56th st, p to end of round.

Working the Chart

-p26 sts, pm, BEGIN CHART, pm, p
last 27 sts

Special Instructions for Chart

Short Rows

Row 16: Beginning of Short Rows

-sm of round beginning, work across chart, sm, p to 11 sts before end of round, wrap this st, turn

-now work the WS (row 17 of chart), k the ks and p the ps (follow the chart) until 11 sts before beginning of the round marker, wrap this st, turn

Row 18:

-work across chart until one st before wrapped st. Wrap the st before the previous wrapped st, turn

-repeat these wraps and turns as outlined in row 18 for each row until chart row 72



Return to Working in the Round

Row 72: Begin working in the round again

-RS: work chart, pick up wrapped sts, p to the beginning of the round marker, sm, p sts, picking up wrapped sts along the way

-sm for chart; you are now on chart row 73



Increases Begin

Row 102:

-sm for beg of round, p to 12 sts before first cable on chart, pfb, p1, pm, p1, pfb; Purl to 1 st before first cable on chart, pfb, WORK CHART

-On first p sts after last cable, pfb, p7 sts, in 8th st pfb, p1, pm, pl, pfb, finish round

Row 106:

- sm for beg of round, p to 2 sts before next m, pfb, p1, sm, p1, pfb, p to 1 st before first cable, pfb WORK CHART

-pfb on first st after last charted cable, p to before next m, pfb, p1, sm, p1, pfb, p to end of round

Row 110: Same as Row 106

Row 114: Same as Row 106

Row 118: Same as Row 106

Finishing Chart

-work 2 rounds in reverse stockinette st.

-Switch to 4.5mm needles and begin working in 1x1 rib.

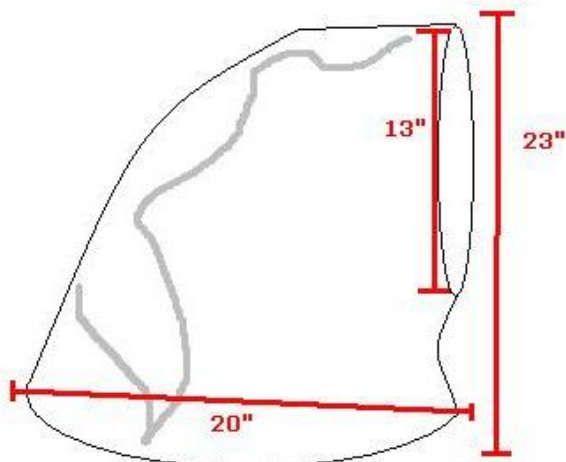
-Work 1x1 rib for 1".

Cast off, being careful not to cast off tightly.

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The Charts

Rows 16-71: Odd numbered rows are the WS of work
(this section is marked by the red box)

Rows 1-15 and 72-138 are worked in the round
