



# CanaryKnits

## Rill

by CanarySanctuary  
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*Rill is a very quick knit, the solution to a one-skein problem that I'd had for ages. With its built-in fastening loop, Rill will keep your neck warm and comfy, even on the windiest of days!*

### Yarn

Handmaiden 12 ply Cashmere; 50 metres

### Gauge

3 sts/1"

### Needles

9.5 mm needles

### Abbreviations

K - knit  
CO - cast on  
Rep - repeat  
Ssk - slip slip knit

CO 12 sts.

K 3 rows in garter stitch.

On 4<sup>th</sup> row, K1, inc. 1, k to end.

K 3 rows.

On 8<sup>th</sup> row, work as 4<sup>th</sup> row.

K 3 rows.

On 12<sup>th</sup> row, work as 4<sup>th</sup> row.

K 3 rows. [15 sts]

On 16<sup>th</sup> row, K6, cast off 3, k last 6.

On 17<sup>th</sup> row, K to cast off gap, cast on 3 (you can use the backwards loop method), k to end.

K 4 rows.

On 22<sup>nd</sup> row, work as 16<sup>th</sup>.

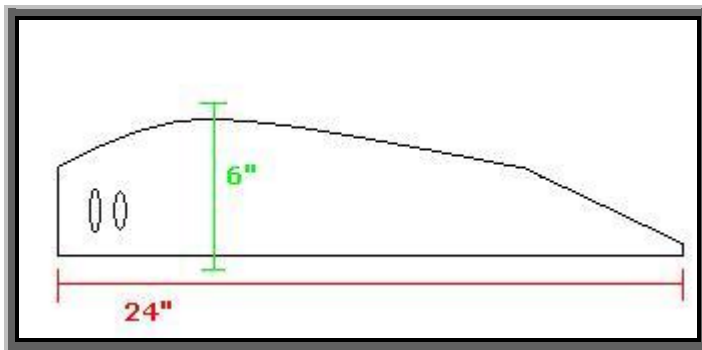
On 23<sup>rd</sup> row, work as 17<sup>th</sup>.

K 2 rows.

On 26<sup>th</sup> row, work as 4<sup>th</sup> row.  
K 3 rows.  
On 30<sup>th</sup> row, work as 4<sup>th</sup> row.  
K 3 rows.  
On 34<sup>th</sup> row, work as 4<sup>th</sup> row.  
K straight for 7".

K1, ssk, k to end.  
K 3 rows.  
Rep these two rows until 4 sts remain.  
Work these 4 sts to end of ball. [approx. 3.5"]  
Draw tail through last 4 sts.
