# Wasabi Cowl

This project can be completed in about an hour! It makes an easy, stylish, and quick gift for a friend or yourself.

#### Pattern:

Cast on 5 stitches.

Knit first row. Place marker on center stitch.

The next four rows will continue will be repeated until you have only a few yards left for binding off:

This pattern is a simple 4 row repeat:

R1: k2, knit until marked st, yo, k marked st, yo, knit until end.

R2: k2, purl until 2 st until end, k2

R3: k2, M1R, knit until 2 sts until end, M1L, k2

R4: k2, purl until 2 st until end, k2

Knit until about 4 or 5 yards remain. BO. Weave in ends. I chose to place the button on the purl side. Choose the side you like best. Place button on either side approximately 3 inches from the top of the widest part of the triangle and 1 inch from the edge. Block if desired. Enjoy!

#### Materials:

- o US Size 19 (15mm) needles
- o 1 ball Colinette Point 5 (100% wool) 54 yds
- o yarn needle
- o 1" button

## Gauge:

5 over 4 inches in stockinette

**Size:** 30" at widest point, 15" from edged to tip of triangle

### Abbreviations:

yo: place the yarn over the needle

M1R: lift the bar between the stitches from the back and place on the needle. Knit new st through the front loop. This should twist the st and make it invisible.

M1L: lift the bar between the stitches from the front and knit new st through the back loop to twist it

Slm: Slip marker
