

# ANGRY BIRDS-YELLOW

FREE CROCHET PATTERN BY CEROTRACE



This is my first pattern. I've tried to write them before but I always just winged it and didn't have patience since I tended to undo and redo until it came out the way I liked. So forgive me if something is a bit off but I think this pattern is rather spot on, but just in case, let me know if something is wrong and I'll fix it. Assemble in whatever order you feel like. I did Body, Belly, Beak, 2 Eyes, 2 Brows, 2 Feathers.

## Abbreviations

Ch: chain

Sc: single crochet

Dec: decrease

Inc: increase

## Materials

Stitch marker- I use a bobby pin instead of the ones you buy at the craft store, it serves the same purpose

Use a hook size appropriate to the yarn you decide to use. I used the yarns "Lily Sugar'n Cream-Sunshine, White, Hot Orange, Black, & Tangerine"

Yarn needle and glue (optional)

Buttons or felt for eyes

## Body-Yellow

**Rnd 1:** Ch 4. Join

**Rnd 2:** sc3 in each ch for 3 ch, sc in next ch

**Rnd 3:** sc in next sc, 3sc in next sc, sc in next 2 sc, 3sc in next sc, sc in next 2 sc, 3sc in next sc, sc in 2 sc.

**Rnd 4:** sc in next 2 sc, 3sc in next sc, sc in next 4 sc, 3 sc in next sc, sc in next 4 sc, 3 sc in next sc, sc in next 3 sc

**Rnd 5-6:** sc around

**Rnd 7:** sc in next 3 sc, 3 sc in next sc, sc in next 6 sc, 3 sc in next sc, sc in next 6 sc, 3 sc in next sc, sc in next 4 sc

**Rnd 8:** sc in next 4 sc, 3 sc in next sc, sc in next 8 sc, 3 sc in next sc, sc in next 8 sc, 3 sc in next sc, sc in next 5 sc

**Rnd 9:** sc around

**Rnd 10:** sc in next 5 sc, 3 sc in next sc, sc in next 10 sc, 3 sc in next sc, sc in next 10 sc, 3 sc in next sc, sc in next 6 sc

**Rnd 11:** sc in next 6 sc, 3 sc in next sc, sc in next 12 sc, 3 sc in next sc, sc in next 12 sc, 2 sc in next sc, sc in next 7 sc

**Rnd 12-13:** sc around

**Rnd 14:** sc in next 5 sc, dec 3 times, sc in next 9 sc, dec three times, sc in next 9 sc, dec three times, sc in next 4 sc

**Rnd 15:** sc in next 3 sc, dec three times, sc in next 6 sc, dec three times, sc in next 6 sc, dec three times, sc in next 3 sc

**Rnd 16:** sc in next 2 sc, dec three times, sc in next 3 sc, dec three times, sc in next 3 sc, dec three times, sc in next sc

**Rnd 17:** dec around and stuff, you can add pennies for weight

**Rnd 18:** dec til closed F/O

Choose a side that you want to be the front

## Feathers-Black

**Row 1:** ch 6



**Row 2:** Sc in 2<sup>nd</sup> sc from hook, sc til end

**Row 3:** Ch 5, sc in 2<sup>nd</sup> sc from hook, sc til end

**Row 4:** ch 4, sc in 2<sup>nd</sup> sc from hook, sc til end. f/o leave long tail for sewing

For the tail use the same format, just have the pattern of chains be short long short (ex. 3, 5, 3)

### Beak-Orange

**Rnd 1:** Magic ring 6

**Rnd 2:** Sc in each sc around

**Rnd 3:** (Inc in sc, sc in next 2 sc) repeat

**Rnd 4:** (Inc in sc, sc in next 3 sc) repeat

**Rnd 5-6:** sc around f/o leave tail for sewing

### Belly-White

**Row 1:** Chain 13

**Row 2:** Sc in 2 ch from hook, sc til end, ch 1 turn

**Row 3:** Sc across, ch 1 turn

**Row 4:** Sc across, ch 1 turn

**Row 5:** Dec, sc 8, dec, ch 1 turn

**Row 6:** Dec, sc 6, dec, f/o leave long string for sewing or glue on (narrow portion on the bottom)

### Eyes-White

**Rnd 1:** Magic ring 6

**Rnd 2:** sc in each sc around. f/o leave long string for sewing or glue

Used black buttons for eyes

### Eyebrows-Tangerine

**Row 1:** Ch 6 turn

**Rnd 2:** Sc in second sc from hook, sc til end. f/o leave long string for sewing or glue
