- Need to know: Increases, Decreases and carrying color up the side of work
- ROYGBIV
- Gauge is as listed on the yarn band




Careful: If you stare too hard you might

get dizzy.

RainbowBlast is a square blanket knit diagonally. The color pattern is such that the color changes bleed into each other (visually speaking). Yarn is carried up the side, so weaving in ends isn't too obnoxious.





Start pattern again with Yellow as Color 1 and Green as Color 2

- Row 1 CO3 (or make 3 out of a single loop for a sharper corner)
 Row 2 P3
 Row 3 K1FB, K1, K1FB (5 st)
 Row 4 Purl all stitches (for this and all remaining even rows)
 Row 5 K1, K1FB, Knit to last 2 stitches, K1FB, K1 (7 st)
- Row 7 Repeat row 5 until you complete one ROYGBIV Color cycle

then:	You should have just finished purling your 10th red row
next odd	Continue in color pattern with: K1, SSK, knit to last 2
row	stitches, K2TOG, K1
	Repeat last row through the 2nd ROYGBIV cycle. You
next odd	should end up with one final loop. Draw yarn through and
row	weave in ends.
