## Itty Bitty Mitt! A Gift from Luvin Ewe!



## Materials:

- Knit Picks Palette or any fingering weight yarn in as many colors as you like!
- Size 2 double pointed needles (4 or 5)
- Stitch holder
- 3 markers



## **Basic mitten pattern:**

CO 19, over 3 needles, placing 6 stitches on needles 1&2, and 7 on needle 3, join, being careful not to twist, by knitting last and first stitches together. Place marker (PM).

Rounds 1-6 \*k1, p1\* to end slipping marker as you come to it in all Rounds.

Round 7-9 K

Round 10 Begin **Thumb Gusset**: k 9 PM, M1 (Make one by either picking upthe yarn between the last stitch and this one, or bykitting into the space between the two stitches, two or three rows back), PM, k9 (19 stitches)

Round 11 K slipping all markers as you come to them.

Round 12, k9,SM (slip marker) m1, k1, m1, SM, k9 (21 stitches)

Round 13 k (slip markers as you come to them)

Round 14 k9 SM m1, k3, m1, SM k9 (23 stitches)

Round 15 k 9 onto first needle, remove marker, k5 onto second needle or stitch holder, remove marker, k9 onto third needle.

Round 16 K9, skip next 5 stitches, k9

Round 17-18 K

Round 19 begin shaping hand. k1, k2tog, k12, ssk, k1 (16 stitches)

Round 20 k

Round 21 k1, k2tog, k10, ssk, k1 (14 stitches)

Round 22 k

Round 23 k1, k2tog, k8, ssk,, k1 (12 stitches)

Round 24 k

Round 25 k1, k2tog, ssk, k2, k2tog, ssk, k1

Round 26 k2tog, ssk, k2tog, ssk

Round 27 k4 tog, cut yarn, slip end through last stitch, pull tight, bury tail inside mitten.
