



Crochet Flower Headband

This is a simple yet elegant crocheted headband with a large flower motif. Although it may be hard to see, there is a small gold button in the center of the flower.

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This headband works well with long hair or short hair alike. It can be worn either as pictured above or around the crown of a brimmed hat as something fun to spice it up.

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Enjoy!

Materials:

- Brown Sheep Lamb's Pride Worsted in turquoise
- Brown Sheep Lamb's Pride Worsted in dark red
- Size K crochet hook
- 36 inch ribbon
- Colorful button
- Needle and thread

Abbreviations:

MC= Main Color

CC= Contrasting Color

Ch= Chain

Sc= Single crochet

Inc= Increase (Single crochet 2 stitches into 1)

Make Flower:

In MC Ch 2, Sc 7 into second stitch from hook. Continue working in rounds.

1. Inc around (14)
2. Inc around (28)
3. Cut yarn and weave in tail. Switch to CC and pick up from the edges of your circle.
4. Sc 2, *Ch 4, skip 2 stitch, Sc 1, rep from * to last 2 stitches, Ch 3, Sc into the loop that you started the round with.
5. Cut yarn and weave in tail.

Join Headband:

6. Tie/sew crocheted flower to the ribbon.
7. Sew your colorful button in the middle of the flower.
8. Wear headband♥
