

Materials:

- Worsted weight yarn in as many colors as desired
- Size K crochet hook
- Yarn needle

Abbreviations:

Ch= Chain

Sc= Single crochet

Inc= Increase (Single crochet 2 stitches into 1)

Sizing:

Cozy should fit all regularly sized (not extra wide) Klean Kanteen water bottles or other similar ones.

Mesh Pattern:

Round 1: *Sc 1 into the space created by the Ch 4 in your last round, Ch 4, rep from * to end of round. Repeat Round 1.

Make Cozy:

Ch 2, Sc 8 into second stitch from hook.

1. Inc around (16)
2. Inc around (32)
3. Cut yarn and weave in tail. Pick up and Sc 1 stitch from the edge of your circle.
4. *Ch 4, skip 3 stitches, Sc 1 into fourth stitch, rep from * to last 3 stitches, Ch 4, Sc 1 into the loop that you started the round with.
5. Work in Mesh Pattern until the cozy reaches the place where the water bottle neck gets narrow. Note that mesh is stretchy and try the cozy on the water bottle to decide how stretched you want the mesh to be.
6. Work one more row of Mesh Pattern. Cut yarn and weave in all loose ends.
7. In worsted weight yarn, preferably another color, Ch desired length for strap. Cut yarn.
8. Thread Chain through the last or second to last round of mesh. Tie both ends of the chain together.
9. Enjoy ☐
