

Yarn:

- Something worsted weight cotton that is **not** fuzzy/clingy (you will be unraveling some stitches which is a lot easier to do with smooth yarn)

Needles:

- 1 set US 7/4.5mm double-pointed needles

Notions:

- Tapestry needle
- Stitch marker

Gauge:

6 stitches = 2 inches in Stockinette Stitch

**Pattern:**

Cast on 63 stitches, place stitch marker and join in the round.

Knit until hat measures approximately 6 inches from cast on edge.

Shape Crown:

Round 1: *Drop 1 stitch and let it unravel all the way down to the cast on edge, k8, repeat from * to end of round.

Round 2: Knit.

Round 3: *Ssk, k7, rep from * to end of round. -56 stitches.

Round 4: Knit.

Round 5: *Ssk, k6, rep from * to end of round. -49 stitches.

Round 6: Knit.

Round 7: *Ssk, k5, rep from * to end of round. -35 stitches.

Round 8: Knit.

Round 9: *Ssk, k4, rep from * to end of round. -28 stitches.

Round 10: Knit.

Round 11: *Ssk, k3, rep from * to end of round. -21 stitches.

Round 12: Knit.

Round 13: *Ssk, k1, rep from * to end of round. -14 stitches.

Round 14: Knit.

Round 15: *Ssk, rep from * to end of round. -7 stitches.

Finishing:

Cut yarn and pull through remaining 7 stitches. Weave in all loose ends.
