



## For the Beanie...

There are a lot of really good FREE earflap hat patterns out there, so I chose one from Petite Purls, but any beanie pattern will do!



## Materials:

- Yarn** Any worsted weight yarn. 1 skein.
- Gauge** 20 sts and 25 rows= 4 inches in St st
- Needle** US #7/4.5 mm 16 inch circular needle and set of 5 dpns (I used straight needles instead, see my video for instructions)  
US #8 Needles

## How to make the Dino Spikes!!!

With size 8 Needles: CO 2

Row 1: k1, yo, k1 (3 sts)

Row 2(and all even rows): p1, knit to last stitch, p1

Row 3: k2, yo, k1 (4 sts)

Row 5: k3, yo, k1 (5 sts)

Row 7: k4, yo, k1 (6 sts)

Row 9: k5, yo, k1 (7 sts)

Row 11: k6, yo, k1 (8 sts)

Row 13: BO 6, k1

- Repeat rows 1-14 until straight edge of your spikes are the same length as your hat or slightly shorter(I made 5). End with row 12.

- BO

- weave ends

- attach to hat
