OVERSIZED BOW HEADBAND

Version 2



MATERIALS

-Dk-Worsted weight(3-4) (hold yarn double with size 3 and a light size 4)

-Size US 8 straight needles

-Tapestry Needle

-Measuring Tape

NOTES

-There are 4 different sizes: Baby, (Toddler, Child, Teen/Adult)

- Work in garter stitch (knit each row) until desired length. Slip the first stitch on every row so you have a neat border.

-Baby Measurements: Headband: ½” wide
Bow: 2 x 3 ½” Loop: 1/3”

-Adult Measurements: Headband: 1¾” w.
Bow: 5 x 6 ½”

ABBREVIATIONS

BO- Bind Off K-Knit

CO-Cast On Sl-slip



Headband

CO 3(5, 6, 7)

All Rows: sl 1, knit to the end of the row.

Repeat until your piece measures 12”(16, 18, 20).

BO. Leave a long tail and sew the ends together. (This will be hidden so don't worry too much about how it looks like)

Bow

CO 10(14, 16, 18)

Knit each row until your piece measures 4”(5, 5, 6). **Don't forget to slip the first stitch on every row!**

BO.

Loop

Place bow on top of headband, wrap yarn around the headband and bow, tie a knot in the back and weave in your ends.
