



# Kim Kardashian Beanie

Materials -US #10 & 11 Circular Needles-12", Cable Needle, Stitch Marker, Tapestry Needle  
(optional-substitute #10 Circular Needle for 4 #10 dpns)

## Pattern:

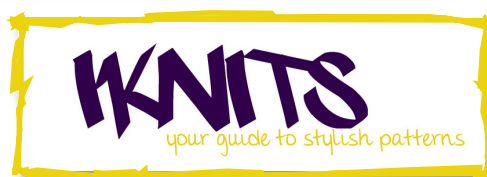
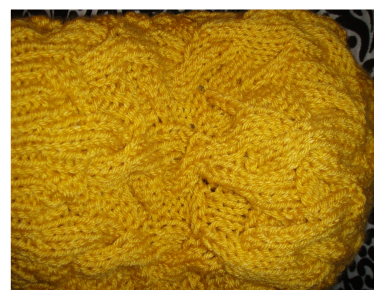
- CO 72 sts via long tail cast-on to US #10 circular needle(or DPNs-divide evenly)
- Join for working in the round and place an EOR marker at the end of the round
- Work in 1x1 rib (K1, P1) for five rows
- Change to US #11 circular needle
- Rows 1-4: \*K3, P3, K3 Repeat from \* to end
- Row 5: \*Slip 3 sts to CN, hold to back, P3, K3 from CN, K3 Repeat from \* to end
- Rows 6-10: \*P3, K6 Repeat from \* to end
- Row 11: \*P3, Slip 3 sts to CN, hold to front, K3, K3 from CN Repeat from \* to end
- Row 12: \*K3, P3, K3 Repeat from \* to end



- Row 13: \*stitch 2(look to see if it's a K or P), m1 Repeat from \* to end (108 sts)
- Row 14-16: K4, \*P5, K9, P4, K9, Repeat from \* to end (at the end, you will only K5, not K9)
- Row 17: Just like row 5(\*Slip 3 sts to CN, hold to back, P3, K3 from CN, K3 Repeat from \* to end) but there are knits and purls in different places. So if you see a knit, knit it, if you see a purl, purl it.
- Rows 18-22: \*P5, K9, P4, K9 Repeat from \* to end
- Row 23: Just like row 11(\*P3, Slip 3 sts to CN, hold to front, K3, K3 from CN Repeat from \* to end) but there are knits and purls in different places. So if you see a knit, knit it, if you see a purl, purl it.
- Repeat rows 14-16 add two more rows (5 rows all together)& 17-18

### Decrease Rows

- Row 1: \*K7, K2tog, K7, SSK Repeat from \* to end (96 sts)
- Row 2: \*K6, K2tog, K6, SSK Repeat from \* to end (84 sts)
- Row 3: \*K5, K2tog, K5, SSK Repeat from \* to end (72 sts)
- Row 4: \*K3, Slip 3 sts to CN, hold to front, K3, K3 from CN Repeat from \* to end
- Row 5: \*Knit
- Row 6: \*K10, K2tog
- Row 7: \*K9, K2tog
- Row 8: \*K8, K2tog
- Row 9: \*K7, K2tog
- Row 10: \*K6, K2tog
- Row 11: \*K5, K2tog
- Row 12: \*K4, K2tog
- Row 13: \*K3, K2tog
- Row 14: \*K2, K2tog
- Row 15: \*K1, K2tog
- Row 16: \*K2tog (6sts)
- Weave through the 6 stitches, tie a knot



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
