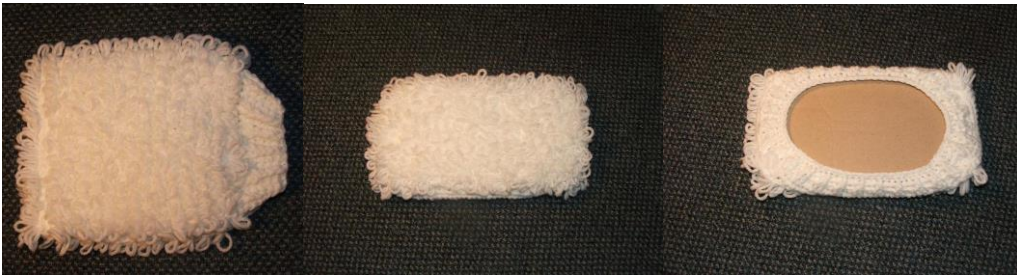


Dry Dust Mop Cover for Swiffer Mop



Skill Level: Easy / Facile / Fácil



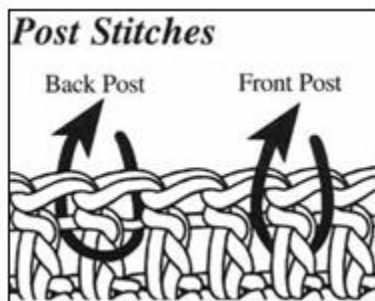
Supplies Used: Size G/6/4mm and H/8/5mm Crochet hook, 3oz worsted weight yarn.

Stitches Used: slst (slip stitch), ch (chain), sc (single crochet), dc (double crochet), dlp (double loop st); fpdc (front post dc), bpdc (back post dc).

Front Post Double Crochet: (fpdc): Yo hook, insert hook from front to back to front around post of indicated st, yo hook, pull up lp, [yo hook, pull through 2 lps] twice.

Back Post Double Crochet: (bpdc): Yo hook, insert hook from back to front to back around post of indicated st, yo hook, pull up lp, [yo hook, pull through 2 lps] twice.

*Unless noted otherwise, always skip the st behind the **fpdc** and the st in front of the **bpdc**.*



Double Loop Stitch (dlp):

Using the left hand finger to control the loop size insert the hook in st indicated, wrap yarn around index finger of left hand twice more and insert hook through lps on finger following direction indicated by arrow (see Fig. 1a), being careful to hook all loops (see Fig. 1b), draw through st pulling each lp to measure approximately 1", remove finger from lp, yo and draw through all lps on hook

Gauge: 4 dlp = 2", 4 pattern rows = 2"

Directions:

Rnd. 1: ch21, sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across, ch1, turn. 20sc

Rnd. 2: sc in first sc; dlp in next 18 sc, sc in last sc; ch1, turn. 20st

Rnd. 3: sc in each st across, ch1, turn. 20sc

Rnds. 4-41: repeat alternating rnd. 2 and 3. 20st

Rnd. 42: working in each sc and each rnd. around; work 121 sc, join with slst to beginning sc. 121sc

Rnd. 43: with G hook; ch3 (counts as first dc), dc in next 121 sc; join with slst to top of beginning ch3. 121dc

Rnd. 44: ch3; *fpdc in next 2 dc; bpdc in next 2 dc*, repeat from *to* around, join with slst to top of beginning ch3. 121dc

Rnd. 45: ch3, *work 1 fpdc over next 2 dc (decrease), bpdc in next 2 dc*, repeat from *to* around, join with slst to beginning sc. 91dc

Rnd. 46: ch1, *sc in next 2 dc; dec sc over next 2 sc*, repeat from *to* around, join with slst to beginning sc; fasten off.

Dust Mitt



Skill Level: Easy / Facile / Facile



Supplies: Size G/6/4mm and H/8/5mm Crochet hook, 7oz worsted weight

Stitches Used: ch (chain), slst (slip stitch), sc (single crochet), dc (double crochet), fpdc (front post double crochet), bpdc (back post double crochet).

Gauge: 4 dlp = 2", 4 pattern rows = 2"

Directions:

Rnd. 1: ch25, sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across, ch 1, turn. 24sc

Rnd. 2: dlp in each sc across, ch1, turn. 24dlp

Rnd. 3: sc in each dlp across, ch1, turn. 24sc

Rnds. 4-59: repeat alternating rnds. 2 and 3, fasten off at end of rnd. 59. 24st

Fold in half, sew side seams.

Ribbing:

Rnd. 1: Attach yarn at any st on top of mitt; working over last sc rnd. on mitt; sc in each sc, join with slst to beginning sc.

Rnd. 2: with G hook; ch3 (counts as first dc), dc in next sc and in each sc around, join with slst to top of beginning ch3.

Rnd. 3: ch3, *fpdc in next 2 dc, bpdc in next 2 dc*, repeat from *to*, join with slst to top of beginning ch3.

Rnd. 4: repeat rnd. 3.

Rnd. 5: ch3, *fpdc over next 2 dc (decrease), bpdc in next 2 dc*, repeat from *to*, join with slst to top of beginning ch3.

Rnd. 6: ch3, *fpdc in next dc, bpdc in next 2 dc*, repeat from *to*, join with slst to top of beginning ch3.

Rnd. 7: repeat rnd. 6, fasten off.
