## Draft Dodger Slippers siees availoble:TeenAAdult-Lurge, Mectium and S nall



Note: Pattern can easily be adjusted using a smaller or larger hook and/or changing yarn weight.

Supplies: 2-3 oz.-Red Heart Super Saver Yarn
Size H/8/5mm Crochet Hook, Yarn Needle.

Stitches Used: ch (chain), slst (slip stitch), sc (single crochet), scdec (decrease single crochet), dc (double crochet), revsc (reverse single crochet).

Reverse Single Crochet (revsc): Working from left to right, *insert hook in next st to right, pull up lp, yo, draw through both lps on hook; rep from* across.


Gauge: 6 pattern stitches $=2 ", 5$ pattern rows $=2 "($ pattern $=s c, d c)$

## Directions for Large (changes for medium and small are in parentheses)

Row 1: leaving a 12 " tail, ch27 ( 25,25 ), sc in $2^{\text {nd }}$ ch from hook and in each ch across, ch1, turn. $26(24,24) \mathrm{sc}$

Row 2: sc in first sc, dc in next sc, *sc in next sc, dc in next sc*, repeat from *to* across. $26(24$, 24)st
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Row 3: sc in first dc, dc in next sc, *sc in next dc, dc in next sc*, repeat from *to* across, ch1, turn. $26(24,24)$ st

Rows 4-14(12, 12): repeat row 3. $26(24,22)$ st (med and small-skip to Row 15)
Row 15: sc in first dc, dc in next sc, *sc in next dc, dc in next sc*, repeat from *to* across, join to beginning sc, ch1, turn. $26(24,24)$ st

Rows 16-22 (22, 20): repeat row 13. $26(24,24)$ st
Row 23: scdec over first 2 st, dcdec over next 2 st, *scdec over next 2 st, dcdec over next 2 st*, repeat across, working an scdec in last st,
(medium and small-scdec over first 2 st, dcdec over next 2 st, *scdec over next 2 st, dcdec over next $2 \mathrm{st}^{*}$, repeat from *to* around), join to beginning sc, ch1, turn. $13(12,12) \mathrm{sc}$

Row 24: scdec over first 2 sc , *scdec over next 2 sc *, repeat from *to* around, sc in last sc, . (medium and small-scdec over first 2 st , ${ }^{\text {scdec over next } 2 \mathrm{st}}$, repeat from $*$ to* around), join to beginning sc, fasten off, leaving 12 " tail7 $(6,6)$ sc

Weave tail through last 7 (6)sc, pull tight, tie to secure.
Using tail, sew back seam, weave in end.
Trim: working around opening, attach yarn at back center, ch1, sc in ends each st around, join to beginning sc, ch1, do not turn.

Rnd. 2: revsc in each sc around, fasten off.
