AG Pioneer Granny Square Outfit



Skill Level: Easy / Facile / Fácil

Supplies: H/8/5mm and F/5/3.75mm crochet hook (or size hook that will maintain gauge), 3 oz worsted weight color 1, 4 oz worsted weight color 2, yarn needle, 2-7/8" buttons, needle and thread.

Stitches Used: ch (chain), slst (slip stitch), sc (single crochet), scdec (decrease single crochet), dc (double crochet).

Note: beginning ch3 counts as first dc.

Gauge: 4 sc = 1 inch, 2 dc rows = 1 inch.

Directions for Granny Square

Rnd. 1: with color 1, H hook, ch4, join with slst to form ring.

Rnd. 2: ch3, 2dc in ring, ch2, *3dc, ch2 in ring*, repeat from *to* twice, join with slst to top of beginning ch3, fasten off color 1. 4 3-dc clusters

Rnd. 3: attach color 2 in ch-2sp, ch3, 2dc, ch2, 3dc in ch-2 sp, *3dc, ch2, 3dc in next ch-2 sp*, repeat from *to* twice, join with slst to top of beginning ch3, fasten off color 2. 8 3-dc clusters

Rnd. 4: attach color 1 in ch-2sp, *4sc in ch-2sp, sc in next 6 dc*, repeat from *to* 3 times, join with slst to beginning sc. 40sc

Poncho

Make 16 granny squares, sew squares together as shown:



Fold in half as shown, with wrong side facing:



Sew to close last 2 squares.

Neckline:

Rnd. 1: color 1, H hook, with right side facing, attach yarn at back, center sc, evenly work 48 sc evenly around, join with slst to beginning sc, do not turn. 48sc

Rnd. 2: sc in each sc around, join with slst to beginning sc. 48sc

Rnd. 3: sc in first sc, ch3, skip next sc, *sc, ch3 in next sc, skip next sc*, repeat from *to* 21 times, ch1, dc in beginning sc. 24 ch-3 loops

Rnd. 4: 2sc in first ch-3 sp, *2sc in next ch-3 sp*, repeat from *to* 22 times, join with slst to beginning sc, fasten off. 48sc

Bottom:

Rnd. 1: color 1,H hook, attach yarn at back center sc on bottom of poncho, evenly work 148 sc around bottom, working 3sc in back and front center sc, join with slst to beginning sc, fasten off. 148sc

Rnd. 2: color 2, attach yarn at back center sc, work 3sc in back and front sc, sc in each sc around, join with slst to beginning sc. 154sc

Rnd. 3: ch3, dc in same st, skip next sc, *sc, ch2, dc in next sc, skip next sc*, repeat from *to* around, join with slst to beginning sc, fasten off.

Tie:

Row 1: color 2, F hook, ch3, *hold last loop of each dc on hook, work 3dc in 3rd ch from hook, yo, pull through all loops on hook*, ch103, repeat from *to* once, fasten off.

Hat

Make 5 Granny Squares

Sew squares as shown:



With wrong sides facing, sew side seams together (will look like an unfinished block)

Border:

Rnd. 1: color 1, H hook, with right sides facing, work 40 sc around bottom of hat, join with slst to beginning sc, fasten off.

Dress

Make 8 Granny Squares

Sew squares as shown:



With right sides facing, fold in half, sew both side seams the length of one square. This will create the bodice and armholes.

Button Back:

Row 1: color 1, H hook, attach yarn at bottom sc on square, work 10 sc up the square, ch1, turn. 10sc

Row 2: sc in each sc, ch1, turn. 10sc

Row 3: sc in each sc, fasten off. 10sc

Button Hole Back

Row 1: color 1, H hook, with right side facing, attach yarn at top sc on bottom back square, work 10 sc down the square, ch1, turn. 10sc

Row 2: sc in first sc, ch2, skip next 2 sc, sc in next 2 sc, ch2, skip next 2 sc, sc in last 2 sc, ch1, turn. 2-button holes

Row 3: sc in first 2 sc, *2sc in ch-2 sp, sc in next 2 sc*, repeat from *to* once, ch1, turn

Row 4: working across bottom of bodice, sc in each sc and sc in end of each rnd. working 54 sc evenly across, fasten off color 1. (this will create base for waistline and skirt)

Row 5: with color 2, attach yarn in last sc worked, ch3, turn, 2dc in same st, skip next sc, *3dc in next sc, skip next sc*, repeat from *to* 24 times, ch3, turn. 26 shells

Rnd. 6: skip 3 dc, *3dc in next space, skip next 3 dc*, repeat from *to* 24 times, skip beginning ch3, join with slst to top of next dc, ch3, turn.

25 shells

Rnd. 7: 2dc in first space, skip next 3 dc, *3dc in next sp, skip next 3 dc*, repeat from *to* 23 times, join to beginning dc, ch3, turn. 25 shells

Rnds. 8-17: repeat Rnd 7, fasten off color 2 at end of Rnd 17. 25 shells *Note: for shorter length dress, fasten off color 2 at end of rnd. 11, skip to rnd. 18.*

Rnd. 18: color 1, attach yarn in next dc, ch3, dc in same st, *2dc in next dc*, repeat from *to* around, join, fasten off. 150 dc

Sleeves

Rnd. 1: color 1, H hook, with right side facing, attach yarn in sc at underarm, evenly work 26sc around arm opening, join with slst to beginning sc, ch1, do not turn. 26 sc

Rnd. 2: sc in each sc around, join to beginning sc, ch1, do not turn. 26 sc

Rnds. 3-4: repeat Rnd. 2, fasten off at end of rnd. 4.

Back and Neckline

Row 1: color 1, H hook, attach yarn at rnd. 1 of waist, working up back, sc in each sc and in each rnd. around back and neckline, fasten off at last sc on waist (*back button hole side*)

Matching buttons to button holes, sew buttons in place.

Shoes



F Hook, Color 2

Rnd. 1: ch6, 2sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in next 3 ch, , 3sc in next ch, working in back loops of beginning ch, sc in next 4 ch, join with slst to beginning sc, ch1, do not turn. 12sc

Rnd. 2: sc in first sc, 2sc in next sc, sc in next 3 sc, 2sc in next sc, sc in next sc, 2sc in next sc, sc in next 3 sc, 2sc in next sc, join to beginning sc, ch1. 16sc

Rnd. 3: sc in first sc, 2sc in next 2 sc, sc in next 3 sc, 2sc in next 2 sc, sc in next sc, 2sc in next 2 sc, sc in next 3 sc, 2sc in next 2 sc, join to beginning sc. 24sc

Rnd. 4: working in back loops, sc in each sc around, join. 24sc

Rnd. 5: working in both loops, sc in each sc around, join to beginning sc. 24sc

Rnd. 6: repeat Rnd. 5. 24sc

Rnd. 7: sc in first 8 sc, scdec over next 2 sc (4 times), sc in last 8 sc, join to beginning sc.

Rnd. 8: ch15, slst in same st, ch1, turn, 15 sc in ring, join to beginning ch, fasten off.
