# AG-Doll Winter Accessories



# Winter Fluff Hat





Skill Level: Easy / Facile / Fácil

**Supplies:** 1 oz worsted weight yarn, (optional) small amount of Bernat Boa size H/8/5mm hook.

Stitches Used: ch (chain), slst (slip stitch), sc (single crochet), dc (double crochet).

## Hood-Directions

**Row 1:** ch17, sc in  $2^{nd}$  ch from hook and in each ch across, ch1, turn. 16sc

**Row 2:** sc in first 2 sc, dc in next 2 sc, \*sc in next 2 sc, dc in next 2 sc\*, repeat from \*to\* twice, ch1, turn. 16st

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Row 3: sc in first 2 dc, dc in next 2 sc, \*sc in next 2 dc, dc in next 2 sc\*, repeat from \*to\* twice, ch1, turn. 16st

Rows 4- 30: repeat Row 3, fasten off leaving long tail to sew center seam. 16st

With right sides facing, fold in half, sew up back seam.


## Neck Trim and Tie

**Row 1:** ch30, with wrong side facing, attach yarn in first st on bottom of hat, sc in every other st across the bottom, ch31, turn.

**Row 2:** slst in 2<sup>nd</sup> ch from hook and in next 29 ch, sc in each sc across bottom of hat, slst in next 30 ch, fasten off.

## Fluff Trim-optional

Row 1: with Bernat Boa, attach yarn at 1st on bottom of hat, sc in each st around the front of hat, fasten off.





Skill Level: Easy / Facile / Fácil



Supplies: <sup>1</sup> 1oz worsted weight yarn, (*optional*)small amount Bernat Boa size F/5/3.75mm crochet hook.

Stitches Used: ch (chain), slst (slip stitch), sc (single crochet).

**Gauge:** 5 sc =  $1^{\circ}$ , 5 sc rows =  $1^{\circ}$ . 

#### Directions:

**Row 1:** ch11,  $sc in 2^{nd}$  ch from hook and in each ch across, ch1, turn. 10sc

**Row 2:** working in back loops, sc in each sc across, ch1, turn. 10sc

**Row 19:** working across top of ribbing, sc in the end of each row across, ch1, turn. 18sc

Row 20: sc in first 8 sc, 2sc in next 2 sc, sc in last 8 sc, ch1, turn. 20sc

**Row 21:** sc in first 8 sc, 2sc in next sc, sc in next 2 sc, 2sc in next sc, sc in last 8 sc, ch1, turn. 22sc

**Row 22:** sc in first 8 sc, skip next 6 sc, sc in last 8 sc, fasten off leaving long tail to sew side seam. 16sc

With right sides facing, sew side seam closed using long tail.

#### Fluff Trim-optional

Attach Bernat Boa at first sc under thumb opening, sc in each sc around hand opening, join to beginning sc, fasten off.



Skill Level: Easy / Facile / Fácil

**Supplies:** 1 oz worsted weight yarn, Size F/5/3.75mm crochet hook, yarn needle.

**Stitches Used:** ch (chain), slst (slip stitch), sc (single crochet), scdec (decrease single crochet).

**Gauge:** 5 sc per inch, 4 sc rows per inch.

### Directions-make 2

**Row 1:** ch6, sc in 2<sup>nd</sup> ch from hook and in each ch across, ch1, turn. 5sc

**Row 2:** working in back loops, sc in each sc, ch1, turn. 5sc

Rows 3-18: repeat Row 2. 5sc

Row 19: working across top of ribbing, sc in end of each row, ch1, turn. 18sc

Row 20: sc in first 8 sc, 2sc in next 2 sc, sc in last 8 sc, ch1, turn. 20sc

**Row 21:** sc in first 8 sc, 2sc in next sc, sc in next 2 sc, 2sc in next sc, sc in last 8 sc, ch1, turn. 22sc

**Row 22:** sc in first 8 sc, skip next 6 sc (*creates thumb opening*), sc in last 8 sc, ch1, turn. 16sc

Row 23: sc in each sc, ch1, turn. 16sc

Rows 24-25: repeat rnd. 23. 16sc

Row 26: scdec over first 2 sc, \*scdec over next 2 sc\*, repeat 6 times, ch1, turn. 8sc

**Row 27:** scdec across 8 sc, fasten off, leaving long tail. 1sc

#### Thumb

**Row 1:** attach yarn at 9<sup>th</sup> sc on Row 20 (*thumb opening*), scdec across 6 sc, fasten off, weave in ends. 1sc

Using tail, wrong side facing, sew side seam of mitten.

#### String (optional)

**Row 1:** attach yarn at top of mitten at side seam, ch75, slst in top of  $2^{nd}$  mitten at side seam, fasten off, weave in end.

Muff



Skill Level: Intermediate / Intermedia

**Supplies:**  $1\frac{4}{2}$  oz worsted weight yarn, Size F/5/3.75mm crochet hook, yarn needle.

Stitches Used: ch (chain), sc (single crochet), dlp (loop stitch)

#### Double Loop Stitch (dlp):

Using the left hand finger to control the loop size insert the hook in st indicated, wrap yarn around index finger of left hand twice more and insert hook through lps on finger following direction indicated by arrow (see Fig. 1a), being careful to hook all loops (see Fig. 1b), draw through st pulling each lp to measure approximately 1", remove finger from lp, yo and draw through all lps on hook

## Directions:

Row 1: ch20, being careful not to twist, join with slst to beginning ch, ch1, do not turn.

**Row 2:** sc in each ch around, join with slst to beginning ch, ch1, do not turn. 20sc

Row 3: sc in each sc around, join with slst to beginning sc, ch1, do not turn. 20sc

Rows 4-6: repeat Row 3, ch1, turn at end of Row 6. 20sc

**Row 7:** dlp in each sc around, join with slst to beginning dlp, ch1, do not turn. 20dlp

**Row 8:** dlp in each dlp around, join with slst to beginning dlp, ch1, do not turn. 20dlp

**Rows. 9-17:** repeat Row 8, ch1, turn at end of Row 17. 20dlp

**Row 18:** sc in each dlp, join with slst to beginning sc, ch1, do not turn. 20sc

Rows 19-23: repeat Row 3, fasten off at end of Row 23, leaving long tail to sew ends.

Fold sc ends into muff, whip stitch ends together, pull seam to inside center of muff.

Fluff Boots



Skill Level: Easy / Facile / Fácil

**Supplies:** 10z worsted weight yarn, Size F/5/3.75mm crochet hook.

Stitches Used: ch (chain), slst (slip stitch), sc (single crochet), dlp (loop stitch-see Muff).

Gauge: 4 sc per inch, 5 sc rows per inch.

#### Directions:

**Rnd. 1:** ch6, sc in  $2^{nd}$  ch from hook, sc in next 3 ch, 3sc in next ch, working in back loops of beginning ch(s), sc in next 4 ch, join with slst to beginning sc, ch1, do not turn. 12sc

**Rnd. 2:** sc in first sc, 2sc in next sc, sc in next 3 sc, 2sc in next sc, sc in next sc, 2sc in next sc, sc in next 3 sc, 2sc in next sc, join to beginning sc, ch1, do not turn. 16sc

**Rnd. 3:** sc in first sc, 2sc in next 2 sc, sc in next 3 sc, 2sc in next 2 sc, sc in next sc, 2sc in next 2 sc, sc in next 3 sc, 2sc in next 2 sc, join to beginning sc, ch1, do not turn. 24sc

**Rnd. 4:** working in back loops, sc in each sc around, join to beginning sc, ch1, do not turn. 24sc

Rnds. 5-6: sc in each sc around, join to beginning sc, ch1, do not turn. 24sc

**Rnd. 7:** sc in first 8 sc, scdec over next 2 sc (4 times), sc in last 8 sc, join to beginning sc, ch1, do not turn. 20sc

**Rnds. 8-12:** repeat Rnd. 5. 20sc

**Rnd. 13:** sc in each sc, join to beginning sc, ch1, turn. 20sc

Rnd. 14: dlp in each sc around, join to beginning dlp, ch1, do not turn. 20dlp

Rnd. 15: dlp in each dlp, join to beginning dlp, fasten off, weave in ends.

Scarf



Skill Level: Easy / Facile / Fácil

**Supplies:** 1oz worsted weight yarn, Size H/8/5mm crochet hook.

Stitches Used: ch (chain), slst (slip stitch).

Gauge: 4 slst per inch, 6 slst rows per inch.

Directions:

Row 1: ch101, turn, slst in each ch across, ch 1, turn. 100slst

Row 2: working in top loops of previous rnd, slst in each slst across, ch1, turn. 100slst

**Row 3:** repeat rnd. 2 until scarf measures 2" wide (or to desired width), fasten off on final Row, weave in ends.
