CROCHETED POOH BEAR



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Materials:

Size G/4mm Crochet Hook
Caron One Pound - Sunflower
Red Heart Super Saver - Red
12mm Black Safety Eyes
21mm Black Safety Nose
Black embroidery floss
Blunt large eyed needle
Polyester Fiberfill
Blunt Needle

Abbreviations:

SC = Single Crochet
Ch = Chain
Rnd(s) = Round(s)
Beg = Beginning
SL ST = Slip Stitch
Sts = Stitches
2tog = Crochet 2 stitches together (decrease)
* = Repeat stitches from * to end of *
2nd = Second

Pattern Notes:

- This pattern is worked in continuous rounds; do not join and do not turn unless specified.
- Use stitch marker to indicate beginning of rounds.
- Yarns listed is what I used - size may vary with other yarns.

Head:

Ch 2

Rnd 1: Work 5 sc in 2nd ch from hook = 5 sc

Rnd 2: Work 2 sc in each sc = 10 sc

Rnd 3: *Sc in first sc, 2 sc in next sc*, repeat from * around = 15 sc

Rnd 4: Sc in each sc around

Rnd 5: *Sc in next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc*, repeat from * around = 20 sc

Rnd 6: *Sc in next 3 sc, 2 sc in next sc*, repeat from * around = 25 sc

Rnd 7: *Sc in next 4 sc, 2 sc in next sc*, repeat from * around = 30 sc

Rnd 8: *Sc in next 5 sc, 2 sc in next sc*, repeat from * around = 35 sc

Rnds 9-15: Sc in each sc around

Rnd 16: *Sc in next 5 sc, sc 2tog*, repeat from * around = 30 sc

Rnd 17: *Sc in next 4 sc, sc 2tog*, repeat from * around = 25 sc

Rnd 18: *Sc in next 3 sc, sc 2tog*, repeat from * around = 20 sc

Rnd 19: *Sc in next 2 sc, sc 2tog*, repeat from * around = 15 sc

Fasten off, leave a tail long enough for sewing. Position and insert safety eyes and safety nose. Stuff head firmly. Sew opening closed. (This will be the back of the head). With black embroidery floss, sew mouth and eyebrows.

NOTE: You can embroider the nose with black embroidery floss if you do not have a safety nose using a satin stitch.

Ears: (Make 2)

Ch 2

Rnd 1: Work 5 sc in 2nd ch from hook = 5 sc

Rnd 2: Work 2 sc in each sc = 10 sc

Rnd 3: *Sc in first sc, 2 sc in next sc*, repeat from * around = 15 sc

Rnd 4: *Sc in next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc*, repeat from * around = 20 sc

Rnd 5: Sc in each sc around

Fasten off, leave a tail long enough for sewing. Fold ears in half and position on head - sew ears on head. Weave in ends.

TIP: I like to assemble my amigurumi as I crochet the pieces. It works up faster that way.

Body:

Ch 2

Rnd 1: Work 5 sc in 2nd ch from hook = 5 sc

Rnd 2: Work 2 sc in each sc = 10 sc

Rnd 3: *Sc in first sc, 2 sc in next sc*, repeat from * around = 15 sc

Rnd 4: *Sc in next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc*, repeat from * around = 20 sc

Rnd 5: *Sc in next 3 sc, 2 sc in next sc*, repeat from * around = 25 sc

Rnd 6: *Sc in next 4 sc, 2 sc in next sc*, repeat from * around = 30 sc

Rnd 7: *Sc in next 5 sc, 2 sc in next sc*, repeat from * around = 35 sc

Rnds 8-16: Sc in each sc around

Rnd 17: *Sc in next 5 sc, sc 2tog*, repeat from * around = 30 sc

Rnd 18: *Sc in next 4 sc, sc 2tog*, repeat from * around = 25 sc

Rnd 19: *Sc in next 3 sc, sc 2tog*, repeat from * around = 20 sc

Rnd 20: *Sc in next 2 sc, sc 2tog*, repeat from * around = 15 sc

Fasten off, leave a long tail for sewing. You will use this piece of yarn to sew the head on to the body. Stuff body firmly. Sew opening closed. Thread yarn through needle - insert needle through bottom and bring yarn up to the top of the body.

Sew head on to body, weave in yarn.

Arms: (Make 2)

Ch 2

Rnd 1: Work 5 sc in 2nd ch from hook = 5 sc

Rnd 2: Work 2 sc in each sc = 10 sc

Rnd 3: Sc in each sc around

Rnds 4-14: Sc in each sc around

Fasten off, leave a tail long enough for sewing. Stuff arms. Sew arms on body just below the head. Weave in yarn.

Legs: (Make 2)

Ch 2

Rnd 1: Work 5 sc in 2nd ch from hook = 5 sc

Rnd 2: Work 2 sc in ea sc = 10 sc

Rnd 3: 2 sc in next sc (only 1 increase), sc in remaining sc = 11 sc

Rnds 4-13: Sc in each sc around

For Feet:

Rnd 14: Work 2 HDC in each of the next 5 sc (10 HDC), sc remaining 6 sts

Rnds 15-16: Sc in each sc around

Stuff leg.

Rnd 17: *Sc in next sc, sc 2tog*, repeat from * around until bottom of foot is closed. Fasten off, leave long tail on for sewing. Thread yarn through needle - insert needle on bottom of foot and bring yarn to top of leg. You will use this piece of yarn to sew the legs on to the body.

NOTE: Sew legs on to body after you put the sweater on.

Sweater: (Make 2 Panels)

With Red Yarn, Ch 25.

Rows 1 - 6: Sc in each sc across, ch 1, turn. (Do not ch 1 at end of last row).

Row 7: Sl st in next 5 sc.

Row 8: Sc in next 14 sc, ch 1, turn. (You will have 5 sc remaining at end of row).

Rows 8 - 13: Sc in each sc across.

Fasten off, leave a tail long enough to sew side seams.

To assemble the top:

1. Lay both pieces on flat surface and count 7 sts from the start of the sleeve to the neck, mark with pin. Repeat with other side.
2. Stitch the seam closed, leaving the neck opening.
3. Stitch down side seams.
4. Weave in ends.
2. To put sweater on bear, dress from the bottom up.

NOTE: Dress bear with sweater before sewing on legs.

Sew legs on body, weave in ends.

Your Ami Pooh Bear is done and ready for adoption!

Ami Pooh Bear measures 7" tall.
