## Pattern



When the pineapple pattern hits the embroidery scissors, you no longer need to worry about being stabbed by the sharp tips. More importantly, the tips wouldn't be easily damaged if you accidently drop them. This pattern includes the size of a typical 4" (10 cm) embroidery scissors. 
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### **Materials:**

- 1 ball of size 20 thread
- 1 mm crochet hook

#### **Instructions:**

- Rnd 1 Start with an adjustable ring (as in amigurumi), work 6 sc in the ring, sl st to join;
- Rnd 2 incl, (sc, inc 1) 3 times to make 10 stitches, sl st to join;
- Rnd 3-6 ch, sc 9, sl st to join;
- Rnd 7-8 ch 2, hdc 9, sl st to join;
- Rnd 9-11 ch 3, dc 9, sl st to join;
- Rnd 12> ch 2, \*skip 2, dc 3, ch 3, dc 3 in the same st, skip 2 st, hdc, repeat from \*, sl st to join;
- Rnd 13> ch 3, \* ch 2, dc at the first st of previous round, dc 3 in the 3 ch of previous rnd, ch 3, dc 3 in the same 3 ch as last dc 3, dc in the hdc, repeat from \*, ch 2, dc in the end of last rnd, sl st to join;
- Rnd 14 sl st, ch 3, \* dc 2 in the ch 2 of last rnd, dc 3 in ch 3, ch 3, dc 3 in same ch 3, dc 3 in ch 2, repeat from \*, sl st to join; sl st, ch 3, \* (dc ch) twice, dc



3 in ch 3, ch 3, dc 3 in same ch 3, (dc ch) 3 times, repeat from \*, sl st to join;

- Rnd 16 ch 6, sc to the 1st dc of 3 dc cluster of last rnd, (\* skip 1 st, dc 3 in the same dc, ch 3, dc 3 in the same st, skip 1 dc 3 ch and another dc, dc 3 in the same dc, ch 3), dc 3 in the same dc, skip 1 st, sc, ch 3, skip two dc and two ch, dc, ch 3, skip 2 dc, sc, repeat the part within (\*), sl st to join;
- Rnd 17 ch 1, \*sc, dc 3 in the ch 3 of last rnd, ch 3, dc 3 in the same ch 3, skip 3 dc, dc, ch 3, dc, dc 3 in the next ch 3, ch 3, dc 3 in the same ch 3, repeat from \*, sl st to join;

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- Rnd 18> ch 2, \* dc 3 in the ch 3 of last rnd, ch 3, dc 3 in the same ch 3, (ch, dc) 4 times in the next ch 3, ch , dc 3 in the next ch 3, ch 3, dc 3 in the same ch 3, hdc in the sc, repeat from \*, sl st to join;
- Rnd 19> ch 2, \* dc 3 in the ch 3 of last rnd, ch 3, dc 3 in the same ch 3, (dc in the first ch ahead, ch, dc in the same ch, ch, dc in the next ch, ch) 2 times, dc in the next ch, ch, dc in the same ch, dc 3 in the next ch 3, ch 3, dc in the same ch 3, hdc, repeat from \*, sl st to join;
- Rnd 20 ch 2, \* dc 3 in the ch 3 of last rnd, ch 3, dc 3 in the same ch 3, ch 2, sc in next ch ahead, (ch 3, sc in next ch ahead) 6 times, ch 2, dc 3 in the next ch 3, ch 3, dc in the same ch 3, hdc, repeat from \*, sl st to join;
- Rnd 21 ch 2, \* dc 3 in the ch 3 of last rnd, ch 3, dc 3 in the same ch 3, ch 2, sc in next ch ahead, (ch 3, sc in next ch ahead) 5 times, ch 2, dc 3 in the next ch 3, ch 3, dc in the same ch 3, hdc, repeat from \*, sl st to join;
- Rnd 22> ch 2, \* dc 3 in the ch 3 of last rnd, ch 3, dc 3 in the same ch 3, ch 2, sc in next ch ahead, (ch 3, sc in next ch ahead) 4 times, ch 3, dc 3 in the next ch 3, ch 2, dc in the same ch 3, hdc, repeat from \*, sl st to join;
- Rnd 23> ch 40, pull the chains through one of the ring bows, sl st to the 10th ch from the hook, sl st another 29 back to the beginning of the chains;
- Rnd 24• from this rnd on, only make half of a round (the blue part) ch 2, dc 3 in the ch 2, ch 3, dc 3 in the same ch 2, (ch 3, sc in next ch ahead) 3 times, ch 3, dc 3 in the next ch 2, ch 3, dc 3 in the same ch 2, hdc;
- Rnd 25 ch 2, **turn**, dc 3 in the ch 2, ch 3, dc 3 in the same ch 2, (ch 3, sc in next ch ahead) 2 times, ch 3, dc 3 in the next ch 2, ch 3, dc 3 in the same ch 2, hdc;
- Rnd 26 ch 2, turn, dc 3 in the ch 2, ch 3, dc 3 in the same ch 2, ch 3, sc in next ch ahead, ch 3, dc 3 in the next ch 2, ch 3, dc 3 in the same ch 2, hdc;
- Rnd 27 ch 2, turn, dc 3 in the ch 2, ch 3, dc 3 in the same ch 2, ch 3, sc, ch 3, dc 3 in the next ch 2, ch 3, dc 3 in the same ch 2, hdc;
- Rnd 28 ch 3, **turn**, dc 3 in the ch 2, ch 3, dc 3 in the same ch 2, dc in the sc, dc 3 in the next ch 2, ch 3, dc 3 in the same ch 2, dc;
- Rnd 29> ch 3, **turn**, dc 3 in the ch 2, ch 3, dc 3 in the same ch 2, hdc in dc, dc 3 in the next ch 2, ch 3, dc 3 in the same ch 2, dc;
- Rnd 30> ch 7, turn, sl st to the 3rd ch of previous rnd, fastern off;
- Finish Add a button at the center of rnd 16 or rnd 17.

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
