

# Jenny and Lexie sweater/cardigan - plain or fair-isle hearts

designed by DollMum in 2015 for 8 inch Jenny and Lexie dolls by Heather Maciak

## Main sweater, starting from neck and working down

This raglan sweater is knitted without seams, from the neck down. It has rib at the neck, bottom and cuffs and moss stitch edges down the front (of 4 stitches width either side). The button holes are knitted evenly down one of the moss stitch edges. Please note the first button hole is made at the start of a row and the other button holes are made at the end of a row. It can be knitted all in one colour or with the fair-isle pattern, using the coloured chart for the fair-isle pattern. Each coloured square on the chart represents one stitch.

[m1, m1 is worked as follows: pick up a stitch between the stitch you have just knitted and the next stitch. Knit into the back of the picked up stitch, then knit into the front of the picked up stitch to make 2 stitches]

Use 2 ply wool and 1.5 mm (size 16 circular needles). 6 safety pins also required as stitch holders for the sleeve holes.

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## Sleeves (24 + 4 stitches)

knit the sleeves in the round using 4 cable needles. There is no purl knitting in the sleeves. When decreasing under the arm you may wish to use one stitch from the end of the previous row in the k2 tog so that the decrease stays in line on the inside arm rather than working slowly round to

Use 2 ply wool and 1.5 mm (4 x size 16 cable needles)

row 1	pick up 4 stitches under arm on cable needles, knit in the round (28 stitches)	
row 2	k1 row	
row 3	k2tog under arm, k1 row (27 sts)	
row 4	k1 row	
row 5	k2tog under arm, k1 row (26 sts)	
row 6	k1 row	
row 7	k2tog under arm, k1 row (25 sts)	
row 8	k1 row	Fair-isle:
row 9	k2tog under arm (24 sts) (first fair-isle row)	k1 main colour, k1 alt colour all round next row
row 10	k1 row	k1 alt colour, k1 main colour all round next row
row 11	k1 row	k1 row main colour
row 12	k1 row	k1 main colour, k1 2nd alt colour
row 13	k1 row	k1 row main colour
row 14	k1 row	k1 alt colour, k1 main colour all round next row
row 15	k1 row	k1 main colour, k1 alt colour all round next row
row 16	k1 row	k1 row main colour
row 17	k1, p1 rib to the end

Sew in all end threads into the inside and trim. Sew on 5 tiny buttons along the moss stitch edge to match the button holes. Press with a cool



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## Main sweater, starting from neck and working down

row 1 k 3 k1 p1 rib or moss stitch  
row 2 p 3 k1 p1 rib or moss stitch  
row 3 k 3 k1 p1 rib or moss stitch  
row 4 k row (moss stitch edges) fair-isle pattern row  
row 5 p row (moss stitch edges) fair-isle pattern row  
row 6 k row (moss stitch edges) fair-isle pattern row  
row 7 p row (moss stitch edges) fair-isle pattern row  
row 8 k row (moss stitch edges) fair-isle pattern row  
row 9 p row (moss stitch edges) fair-isle pattern row  
row 10 k row (moss stitch edges) fair-isle pattern row  
row 11 p row (moss stitch edges) fair-isle pattern row

## Sleeves (24 + 4 stitches)

Use 2 ply wool and 1.5 mm (4 x size 16 cable needles)  
row 1 pick up 4 stitches under arm on cable needles, knit in the round (28 stitches)

row 2 k1 row  
row 3 k2 tog under arm, k1 row (27 sts)  
row 4 k1 row  
row 5 k2 tog under arm, k1 row (26 sts)  
row 6 k1 row  
row 7 k2 tog under arm, k1 row (25 sts)  
row 8 k1 row  
row 9 k2 tog under arm (24 sts) (first fair-isle row)  
row 10 k1 row  
row 11 k1 row  
row 12 k1 row  
row 13 k1 row  
row 14 k1 row  
row 15 k1 row  
row 16 k1 row  
row 17 k1, p1 rib to the end  
row 18 k1, p1 rib to the end  
row 19 k1, p1 rib to the end  
row 20 k1, p1 rib to the end  
row 21 cast off

Fair-isle pattern:  
k1 main colour, k1 alt colour all round next ro  
k1 alt colour, k1 main colour all round next ro  
k1 row main colour  
k1 main colour, k1 2nd alt colour  
k1 row main colour  
k1 alt colour, k1 main colour all round next ro  
k1 main colour, k1 alt colour all round next ro  
k1 row main colour
