



What you Need:

- -worsted weight yarn
- -size 8 16" circular needles
- -yarn needle & stitch marker

Let's start! Headband:

- 1. CO 70 stitches using the long tail cast on. Place marker and join in the round, being careful not to twist.
- 2. *k1, p1* around for 5 rounds
- 3. Knit until three stitches before the marker, turn.
- 4. Purl (on the wrong side now) until three before the marker, turn.
- 5. Knit until five stitches before the marker, turn.
- 6. Purl (on the wrong side now) until five before the marker, turn.
- 7. Knit until seven stitches before the marker, turn.
- 8. Purl (on the wrong side now) until seven before the marker, turn.
- 9. Knit until five stitches before the marker, turn.
- 10. Purl (on the wrong side now) until five before the marker, turn.
- 11. Knit until three stitches before the marker, turn.
- 12. Purl (on the wrong side now) until three before the marker, turn.
- 13. Work ribbing again.
- 14. BO loosely.

Bow:

- 1. CO 3 stitches.
- 2. Work garter stitch for 1"
- 3. Kfb, k1, kfb
- 4. Knit
- 5. Kfb, knit 3, kfb.
- 6. Work garter stitch for 7"
- 7. K2tog, k3, k2tog
- 8. Knit
- 9. K2tog, k1, k2tog
- 10. Work garter stitch for 1"
- 11. BO.

Now it's time to sew it up: lay your piece flat and fold each end in to the middle and pull the little ends down. (this is hard to explain, just play around with it.) Take more yarn and wrap around the middle, keeping the little ends in place. Sew to your headband!
