

# Latte Cowl

A Brioche stitch cowl in two sizes © 2011 Elizabeth Prose

Sizes: Half Caff: 8" x 25.5" (Full Caff: 8" x 54.5")

# **Materials:**

- Two 50 gram (100 gram) skeins worsted weight yarn, one dark color (A) and one light color (B), Full Caff sample shown uses *Angel's Kiss* worsted weight 220 yds/100 grams in Brown Heather and Ivory
- Size 8-16 (32) inch circular needle or size to suit yarn
- Stitch marker
- Crochet hook
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**Gauge:** 11 sts = 4" in stitch pattern blocked

#### Cast-on:

With <u>Dark Color</u> and using crochet cast on, loosely cast-on 70 (150) stitches. Place a marker and join to work in the round being careful not to twist the stitches.

### Set up:

*Set-up round 1A:* <u>Dark Color</u> \*Knit 1, bring yarn to front (between the needles), slip 1 purlwise, bring yarn to back over right needle (this creates a yarn-over over the slipped stitch); repeat from\*. Leave yarn in back.

Set up round 1B: Light Color \*Yarn in front, slip 1 purlwise, yarn-over (this creates a yarn-over over the slipped stitch), yarn to front, purl the next stitch and its yarn-over together; repeat from\*. Leave yarn in front.

*Set up round 2A:* <u>Dark Color</u> \*Yarn in back, knit the next stitch and its yarn-over together, bring yarn to front (between the needles), slip 1 purlwise, bring yarn to back over right needle (this creates a yarn-over over the slipped stitch); repeat from\*. Leave yarn in back.

*Set up round 2B:* <u>Light Color</u> \*Yarn in front, slip 1 purlwise, yarn-over (this creates a yarn-over over the slipped stitch), yarn to front, purl the next stitch and its yarn-over together; repeat from\*. Leave yarn in front.

Repeat set up rounds 2A and 2B one time more.

# Pattern:

*Round 1A:* <u>Dark Color</u> \*Yarn in front, purl the next stitch and its yarn-over together, slip 1 purlwise, yarn-over (this creates a yarn-over over the slipped stitch); repeat from\*. Leave yarn in front.

*Round 1B:* <u>Light Color</u> \*Yarn in front, slip 1 purlwise, bring yarn to back over right needle (this creates a yarn-over over the slipped stitch), knit the next stitch and its yarn-over together; repeat from\*. Leave yarn in back.

Repeat rounds 1A and 1B two times more.

*Round 2A:* <u>Dark Color</u> \*Yarn in back, knit the next stitch and its yarn-over together, bring yarn to front (between the needles), slip 1 purlwise, bring yarn to back over right needle (this creates a yarn-over over the slipped stitch); repeat from\*. Leave yarn in back.

*Round 2B:* <u>Light Color</u> \*Yarn in front, slip 1 purlwise, yarn-over (this creates a yarn-over over the slipped stitch), yarn to front, purl the next stitch and its yarn-over together; repeat from\*. Leave yarn in front.

Repeat rounds 2A and 2B two times more.

#### Cowl:

Work pattern sequence 4 times more for a total of 5 repeats.

#### Finishing:

Bind off in 1x1 (knit 1, purl 1) rib with <u>Dark Color</u> very loosely. Weave in ends and block.
