

# Midwinter's Night Cowl

A cowl for handspun or colorful bulky yarn

110-180 yards (101-164 meters) bulky or heavy Aran weight yarn  
such as di.vé Fiamma -or- Hedgehog Fibres merino aran  
9 mm or 13 US circular knitting needles



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CO 34 stitches.

Join in the round being careful not to twist.

[K2, P2] for all stitches, joining skeins\* as needed, until you have only a couple yards left then proceed with bind off.


Loosely bind off or use a surprisingly stretchy bind off.

\*Use the Russian Join or the Felted Join if knitting with multiple skeins then proceed with your knitting.

Pull the remaining yarn tail through the final loop to knot it off.

Leave a few inches of a tail then trim any excess yarn. Weave in the ends.

If needed, gently block with steam iron and cotton dishcloth between iron and cowl.



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
