

Quick Cabled Cowl

Materials

Suggested Yarn: 2 Balls of AdriaFil Charme (51yds / 46m per 50g ball)

Knitting Needles: 7mm and a cable needle

Notions: 2 x buttons (3-3.5cm), darning needle, sewing needle and thread

Tension



4 inches = 16 rows and 12 stitches over garter stitch.

Please check your tension if using AdriaFil Charme as this knit is very efficient in terms of its yarn usage.

Special Abbreviation

C5F: Transfer the next 5 stitches onto a cable needle. Hold the cable needle to the front of your knitting. Knit the next 5 stitches of the row. Then knit the 5 stitches from the cable needle.

Instructions

Section A (set up rows):

Cast on 23 stitches

Rows 1 – 4: knit

Row 5: K4, P2, K5, P1, K5, P2, K4

Row 6: K6, P5, K1, P5, K6

Rows 7 – 12: repeat rows 5 and 6 (from Section A)

Row 13 (Cable Row): K4, P2, C5F, P3, K4

Row 14: K6, P5, K1, P5, K6

Section B (main body rows):

Row 1: K4, P2, K5, P1, K5, P2, K4

Row 2: K6, P5, K1, P5, K6

Rows 3 – 10: repeat rows 1 and 2 (from Section B)

Row 11 (Cable Row): K4, P2, C5F, P3, K4

Row 12: K6, P5, K1, P5, K6

Repeat rows 1 – 12, 6 times (from Section B)

Section C (finishing off rows):

Row 1: K4, P2, K5, P1, K5, P2, K4

Row 2: K6, P5, K1, P5, K6

Rows 3 and 4: repeat rows 1 and 2 (from Section C)

Row 5 (Buttonhole Row 1): K4, P2, K1. Bind off the next 2 stitches of your row in knit stitch*. Then, K1, P1, K2. Bind off the next 2 stitches of your row in knit stitch. Then, P2, K4

***Note:** *in order to bind off 2 stitches, you end up working the next 3 stitches of your row.*

Row 6 (Buttonhole Row 2): K6, P1, cast on 2 stitches, P2, K1, P2, cast on 2 stitches, P1, K6

Rows 7 and 8: repeat rows 1 and 2 (from Section C)

Row 9: K4, P2, K5, P1, K5, P2, K4

Rows: 10 - 12 knit

Row 13: bind off all stitches.

Weave in ends.

Sew on buttons as shown in image on Page 1 and enjoy your knit!
