

## **Baby Heart Hat**

Needles: 5mm/ Size 8,


Double Pointed Needles (DPN), set of 4

Yarn: Worsted Weight (LB Wool Ease) Other: Needle, to weave in ends

Size: NB (0-6 mo., 6-12 mo.)

Gauge: 5 stitches per inch or 20 sts/4 in.

## Heart Pattern



(remember start on bottom and work to top, right to left)

K3tog= Knit 3 together

\*Cast on 60 (66, 72) stitches, evenly distributing on 3 DPNs

\*Knit 8 ribbing rows as follows: K2, P2

\*Knit 2 rows







\*Start Heart Pattern, working from bottom to top. For NB size, work 1.5 sets (or 18 rows) and for bigger sizes, work 2 complete sets (or 24 rows).

\*Knit 1 row

\*Begin decrease as follows:

Making sure needles have stitches evenly distributed, K3tog at the beginning of each needle and at the end of each needle. Do this every round until there are 6 stitches left or 2 stitches on each needle.

\*Break yarn, pull through remaining stitches, and secure.

## MAKE A CUTE POMPOM:

You can use either a pompom maker, or here is an easy way to make a pompom without a pompom maker:

Wrap yarn around two fingers until desired thickness. Cut varn, leaving a tail. Pull off yarn from fingers, leaving its form intact. Take tail of varn and tie all of the yarn together. With scissors, snip. Fluff. ... TADAH!!!

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
